

Division of Line Fence

This agreement made this 14th day of December 1859 between Stephen Millett, party of the first part and William Dole, Party of the second part, all of the Town of Beloit, County of Rock, State of Wisconsin witnesseth.

It is agreed in regard to the partition fence between the premises of said parties - upon the S.W. 1/4 of Section 10 and the S.E. 1/4 of Section 9, Town 1, Range 12 East, Beloit, Rock County, Wisconsin. This division includes only about 138 rods beginning at the South end of said line, and the said William Dole agrees to make and keep the South half of said 138 rods of fence and the said S. C. Millett agrees to make and keep the North half of said 138 rods of fence. In witness hereof the said parties have hereby set their hands and seals this day and year above written.
