1984 BARNES N-9 FOUND CUT LIMESTONE & REFERENCED SAME.

1995 BARNES N-9(1) FOUND LARGE PIECES OF CUT LIMESTONE WITH 3/8" REROD IN THE CENTER & CARSONITE POST.

MONUMENT DESTROYED BY STORM SEWER LINE. MANY OF THE SUBDIVISION MONUMENTS THAT WERE USED AS REFERENCE MONUMENTS WERE REPLACED AND USUALLY DID NOT AGREE WITH OLD MONUMENT RECORD. JIM WOODMAN PROVIDED DATA FROM CONTROL POINTS WHICH WAS USED TO PLACE AN ALUMINUM MONUMENT. THIS WAS IN HARMONY WITH OLD RECORD ANGLES AND DISTANCES. PLACED CARSONITE POST ON SOUTH SIDE OF MONUMENT. MONUMENT IS ABOUT .5 ABOVE GRADE.
