


WIDOT PROVIDED THE NAD83(91) STATE PLANE COORDINATES AND DESCRIBED THE MONUMENT THEY FOUND. THEY ESTABLISHED THE COORDINATES BY TRAVERSING FROM GPS STATIONS THAT THEY ESTABLISHED PRIOR TO THE ROCK COUNTY GPS NETWORK. I TRANSCRIBED THERE INFORMATION TO THIS SHEET. I ALSO CONVERTED THE STATE PLANE COORDINATES TO THE LATITUDE/LONGITUDE AND ROCK COUNTY COORDINATES THAT ARE SHOWN.

SHOW A PLAN VIEW DRAWING DEPICTING THE CORNER MONUMENT AND SURROUNDING PHYSICAL FEATURES, INCLUDING THE EXCAVATION AREA AND DEPTH. THE CORNER MONUMENT SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING CHARACTERISTICS. 1) HAVE AT LEAST TWO PREDETERMINED BREAK-OFF POINTS. 2) IF BROKEN, LEAVE A PERMANENTLY MAGNETIZED REMNANT AT THE ORIGINAL POINT. 3) MUST BE EXTENDABLE. 4) THE CAP IS INSCRIBED. ROCK COUNTY SURVEY MONUMENT - PENALTY FOR DISTURBING MARKER. 5) OR AN EXISTING CUT LIMESTONE. AN IRON PIPE 1 2 2 4 0" (MINIMUM) MAY BE USED IN AREAS WHERE GNOUND WATER IS WITHIN ONE FOOT OF THE SURFACE. IF THE CORNER IS OCCUPIED BY AN IMPROVEMENT (MANHOLE, BURIED CABLE, ETC.) ANY DURABLE, DISTINCT MONUMENT MAY BE USED. CORNERS SHALL BE REFERENCED WITH AT LEAST 4 DURABLE WITNESS MONUMENTS. WITNESS MONUMENTS SHALL BE MADE OF CONCRETE, NATURAL STONE, IRON OR OTHER EQUALLY DURABLE MATERIAL, EXCEPT WOOD. DESCRIBE THE CORNER AND THE WITNESS MONUMENTS.
