1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Rock County Planning & Development Committee was called to order at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 25, 2012 at the Rock County Courthouse. Chair Al Sweeney presided. Supervisors present: Wayne Gustina, Marilynn Jensen, Mary Mawhinney and Phil Owens.

2. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Supervisor Owens moved to adopt the agenda, Supervisor Gustina seconded. **ADOPTED** 5-0.

4. CITIZEN PARTICIPATION, COMMUNICATIONS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

5. CODE ADMINISTRATION & ENFORCEMENT

Action Item: Public Hearing – Shoreland Conditional Use Permit 2012 003 – Gary Fossum (landowner) and Burtness Chevrolet (developer) to construct a car dealership partially within the Floodplain of Swan Creek (Spring Valley Township).

Supervisor Jensen moved to go into public hearing; second by Supervisor Owens. All in favor – Approved (Yes – 5, No – 0, Absent – 0)

Colin Byrnes gave a presentation of the project being proposed and referenced map and plat plan of the building site.

Katie Udell, representing Angus-Young explained the details of the project.

- ➤ County Engineer The Position Description (PD) has been redrafted to include housing inspection and water quality planning experience. The due date to apply for the position ends on October 26, 2012.
- ➤ Village of Orfordville CDBG Small Cities Grant Mr. Benjamin has office hours at the Village on Monday and Wednesday afternoons. So far 6 applications have been submitted.
- Farmland Preservation Planning Open House 12 –15 people attended last weeks Open House. Staff is still working on completing the farmland maps.
- > Contracting for Housing Inspectors Interviews were held and no one was deemed able to fill the position. The position will be reposted.
