IN SUPPORT OF GOVERNOR EVERS' 2021-2023 EXECUTIVE BUDGET PROPOSALS FOR **CAREGIVERS**

WHEREAS, the percentage of Wisconsin's population age 65 and older is increasing; and

WHEREAS. Wisconsin faces a critical shortage of direct care workers that leaves families and individuals struggling to meet care needs; and 4

WHEREAS, people with chronic conditions and disabilities are living longer, contributing to an even higher demand for family caregivers in Wisconsin's future; and 7

WHEREAS, preliminary results of a 2019 Family Caregiver Survey conducted for the Wisconsin Family and Caregiver Support Alliance report that majority of the 612 survey respondents experience 10 caregiving difficulties, which include: 11

- Not meeting their own personal care needs -73%.
- Not balancing caregiving and work -63%. 14
- Not balancing the needs of children and other family members -60%. 15
- Not understanding government programs such as Medicaid, Medicare, SSI, etc. 53%.

- WHEREAS, a majority of family caregivers who responded to this survey also noted personal impacts 18 19 such as:
- Fatigue 72%. 20
- Decreased social life 64%. 21
- Negative impacts on relationships with friends and/or family 53%. 22
- Worsening emotional and/or physical health 90%. 23

WHEREAS, the emergence of the COVID-19 Pandemic has further heightened the need to implement 25 additional supports for family caregivers; and 26

- WHEREAS, the Governor's proposed 2021-2023 Executive Budget contains initiatives to support 28 family caregivers, which include: 29
- Investing over \$200 million to support family caregiving by creating a Caregiving Tax Credit 30 that provides up to a \$500 credit for qualified caregiving expenses. 31
- Providing additional funding for Aging and Disability Resource Centers, expands the dementia 32 care specialist program statewide, expands the tribal aging and disability resources specialist 33 program, the tribal disability benefit specialist program, and extends caregiver support services 34 to address the needs of caregivers of adults with disabilities who are age 19 to 59. 35
- Funding expansion of the Alzheimer's Family Caregiving Support program which provides 36 assistance to low-and-middle-income families throughout the state that have a family member 37 who is suffering from Alzheimer's disease, dementia, or another related memory disorder. 38

- Creating a pilot Tailored Caregiver Assessment and Referral (TCARE) program for family caregivers to provide evidence-based care management protocols designed to support family caregivers of adults with chronic or acute health conditions.
- Allowing family caregivers to use Wisconsin FMLA leave for those with chronic conditions for caregiving responsibilities and expand the list of individuals covered to include grandparents, grandchildren, and siblings.
- Providing funding to support a Family and Guardian Training Program as well as additional Ombudsmen positions at the Board of Aging and Long-Term Care.
- Ensuring that all eligible children receive service under the Children's Long-Term Support waiver program, providing long-term services to children with intellectual, physical and/or developmental disabilities, and severe emotional disturbances.
- Establishing requirements and standards for hospitals relating to caregivers when discharging patients.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this <u>13th</u> day of <u>May</u>, 2021, does hereby support the family caregiver support initiatives proposed by Governor Tony Evers and urge the Wisconsin State Legislature to include them in the 2021-2023 Wisconsin State Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Rock County Clerk be authorized and directed to send copies of this resolution to Governor Evers, the Wisconsin Counties Association, and members of the Wisconsin State Legislature representing Rock County.
