Executive Summary

Awarding Contract for Flooring Transition Strip Replacement at Rock Haven

Rock Haven Nursing Home has several different types of flooring. It has sheet vinyl, carpet and ceramic tile. At the time of construction a transition strip material was installed where two different types of flooring meet that have different heights. The transition strip style that was installed sticks up 1/4 of an inch higher than the thickest flooring material creating a trip hazard.

This resolution will replace all the current transition strips with low profile transition strips to reduce the risk of falls. These strips are located at the entrance to each resident's bathroom and the dining areas. The resolution approves contracting with Halverson Flooring for \$34,200. Halverson flooring holds the current state contract for flooring.
