Executive Summary for Expansion of the County's Storage Area Network

As an IT capital project included in the 2013 budget, the expansion of the County's storage area network (SAN) is planned to address the County's rapidly growing storage requirements for both structured and unstructured County information. The storage area network consists of controllers, magnetic disk drives, and software that represent the primary information storage for the County's computer systems. The expanded SAN will allow for greater throughput of input/output data operations as well as the necessary increase in raw storage capacity.

The SAN expansion project consists of the following main components:

- 26 terabytes of additional Hitachi Data Systems storage capacity
- Rack-mounted Storage Expansion Tray and Rack Rails
- Installation
- 3 Years Premium Service
- Hitachi Command Suite Software.

The SAN is located in the County's data center at the Health Care Center.

The purpose of the upgrade is to allow for the centralized patching and upgrading of application software, centralized repairing of virus effects, and the centralized provisioning of new application and operating system software. XenApp Enterprise also delivers a consistent virtual desktop interface allowing users to access their applications from any location and from any device that is on the County's network or the Internet.

The project is the next step of the existing long-term project of Citrix technology that has been in-process within the County's computer and network environment, and the project has relied on the professional services of EDCI, Inc. the leading implementation provider of Citrix enterprise solutions in the state of Wisconsin.

The main components of the project include:

- The XenApp Enterprise system software (\$35,052) funded by the IT Capital Projects account (07-1444-0000-62491), and

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rock County 911 Communications Center is the records custodian for all Rock County public safety audio recordings. The recent conversion of the Public Safety Radio System to a conventional digital system in 2012, it is necessary to upgrade our current analog recording system to digital. This upgrade will enhance the audio recordings from the new radio system making the audio more crisp and clear, as well as offer new features that are not possible on an analog system (i.e; recording of unit ID numbers on radio transmissions). Currently the recording system is connected to control stations at the Sheriff's Department, so we are unable to verify the signals that the dispatch consoles transmit/receive because the system is unable to do so until we complete the upgrade.

Upgrading to a digital recorder will also allow for more functionality (ie; recording caller ID, 911 data feeds, etc.) for telephone recordings when we update our 911 telephone system in late 2013.

General Communications was the original vendor for the analog Eventide recorder and currently holds the maintenance contract for the recording system equipment as well as the interface between the recorder and the dispatch radio consoles.

This item was approved in the Communications Center's 2013 budget and pricing for the quote (\$40,068.75) is based on GSA Contract #GS-35F-0415V.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rock County Communications Center is responsible for the management of the County's Public Safety Digital Radio System. For the past several months radio equipment vendors and Rock County personnel have been troubleshooting the remaining communications issues on the new P25 digital radio system. The main issue remaining concerns dropped and garbled audio packets. Through the troubleshooting process a recommendation was made to segregate Rock County's radio network from other data networks.

Part of this process requires different, more enhanced switches at the various tower sites. Rock County IT has recommended that the Communications Center purchase (8) new Cisco Catalyst 2960S 24-port switches this year in order to begin this segregation. The Cisco switches were recommended for the following reasons:

- Will improve traffic on the network
- Allows for multiple VLANs
- Will allow for remote management
- Switches will eventually all be the same brand, which will streamline configuration and troubleshooting

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This resolution authorizes the Land Conservation Department (LCD) to finalize acquisition of the Agricultural Conservation Easements under the Purchase of Agricultural Conservation Easement Program (PACE) for the following lands:

- 1. Carlson Property: Rock County Tax Parcel Numbers 6-5-304 and 6-5-325, Sections 32 and 33, Town of Clinton;
- 2. Phelps Property: Rock County Tax Parcel Numbers 6-20-100, 6-20-101.1, and 6-20-104A, Sections 12 and 13, Town of Union;
- 3. Anderson Property: Rock County Tax Parcel Number 6-11-120, Section 17, Town of Lima

Acquisition of Easements will protect and preserve productive agricultural lands in Rock County, encouraging and promoting the goals of a strong agricultural economy and community identity, intergovernmental cooperation, and a regional land use vision throughout the County.

A Real Estate Appraisal Review, requested by the NRCS has been completed on the initial easement appraisals and the reviewer requested changes. The Real Estate Appraiser has made said changes, which has altered the initial values plus six percent (6%). Due to the changes, the LCD is requesting a ten percent (10%) contingency fund to be set up to cover a potential for increases in the Real Estate Appraisals for each property.

If this resolution is approved, the LCD will complete the Easement acquisition process on each of the aforementioned properties, and submit Easement acquisition funding applications to the USDA-Farm and Ranch Land Protection Program. Acquisition of the easements by Rock County is contingent upon funding from the USDA.
