FINANCE COMMITTEE Minutes – April 18, 2013

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Mawhinney called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, April 18, 2013, in Conference Room N-1 Rock County Courthouse East.

Committee Members Present. Supervisors Mawhinney, Beaver, Fox and Podzilni.

Committee Members Excused: Supervisor Kraft.

<u>Staff Members Present</u>. Sherry Oja, Finance Director; Craig Knutson, County Administrator; Randy Terronez and Nick Osborne, Assistants to County Administrator; Mickey Crittenden, Information Technology Director; Vicki Brown, Treasurer.

Others Present: Marc McClure and Bruce Ely, Cutwater Asset Management.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>. Chair Mawhinney said there was an addition of three transfers for the Finance Department (item 5.B.) and item 9.A. should be deleted. Supervisor Fox moved approval of the agenda with these changes, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements.</u> Ms. Brown informed the Committee there are 139 foreclosures from 2009 they will need to tour in August and this could take more than one day.

Mr. Knutson informed the Committee that Emergency Management will be purchasing additional sandbags from another source as the State is out of sandbags at this time.

<u>Approval of Minutes – April 4, 2013.</u> Supervisor Beaver moved approval of the minutes of April 4, 2013 as presented, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

Report by Cutwater Asset Management. Mr. McClure went over charts on the following: Federal Funds Target Rate, Comparative Historical Yield Curves, Daily Yield of 2-Year Treasury Notes, Weekly Yield of 2-Year Treasury Notes, the Spread Relationship of the 2-Year Treasury Notes versus the Ten-Year Treasury, the Producer Price Index, Consumer Price Index, Oil Price/Barrel, Gross Domestic Product, Manufacturing versus Non-Manufacturing Business Activity, Retail Sales, Unemployment and Underemployment, New Home Sales, and Existing Home Sales. Mr. McClure said the Feds will probably not do anything with rates until mid 2015.

Mr. McClure then went over Rock County comparison yields from April 2010 through March 2013 on the following: Amortized Cost Basis, Fair Value Basis, Rock County Portfolio Size and Weighted Average Maturity, Weighted Average Final Maturity and Weighted Average Effective Average. He also went over their report on Rock County for March 2013, Rock County January 1, 2012 – December 31, 2012.

Ms. Brown asked Mr. McClure his thoughts about using Letters of Credit vs. U.S. Government issued securities as collateral for bank deposits. Mr. McClure said he is very comfortable with both.
