BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that payments be made to the vendor upon approval of the General Services Committee; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2012 budget be amended as follows to pay for architectural services and quality assurance:

Mr. Boutwell said Ms. Thompson would be responsible for oversight of the ADRC, the State is requiring we have an ADRC, and the ADRC would be operating out of the Job Center. He added that the plan is to have the ADRC up and running on March 4, 2013. The total project would be approximately \$255,000 and Samuel's would be doing quality assurance.
