WHEREAS, the Human Services Department implemented Netsmart Avatar (Avatar) a comprehensive Electronic Health Record software solution in 2013 after a Request for Qualifications 2 and Cost Proposal (#2011-69) was issued and Netsmart was awarded the contract; and, 3 4 5 WHEREAS. Authorizing Purchase of Netsmart Avatar Module

Executive Summary

The Human Services Department implemented Netsmart Avatar (Avatar) a comprehensive Electronic Health Record (EHR) software solution in 2013. In 2011 a Request for Qualifications and Cost Proposal (#2011-69) was issued and Netsmart was awarded the contract.

Avatar is a module based solution and the initial purchase only included the modules that provided clinical documentation, client management and billing capabilities. The Department is now requesting to purchase the Managed Services Organization (MSO) module which will provide the capability for HSD to provide better management and accountability for services that are provided by contracted agencies.

HSD contracts with approximately two hundred providers throughout the Department that provide mental health and AODA treatment and services, and in-home and out-of-home services to adults, children, youth and families. The MSO module will significantly improve the ability of the Department to manage contracted services by providing a central electronic location for contract compliance tracking and funding authorizations.

The cost of the MSO module is \$10,000 with an additional \$45,180 in professional services costs for implementation, and a \$2,100 annual maintenance charge for a total of \$57,280.

Of the 12 other Wisconsin Counties using Avatar, nearly all of them have purchased this module as a key component of their EHR solution. When HSD made the initial purchase a decision was made to only implement a few core modules and focus on ensuring successful implementation before expanding to other needed modules.

The Arrowhead Library System (ALS) has been awarded a 2015 LSTA Public Library System Accessibility in Public Libraries Grant to install a total of three meeting/program room hearing loop systems. These Hearing loop systems are to be installed in the Beloit, Edgerton and Hedberg (Janesville) Public Libraries. It is also the intention of this grant to raise awareness of the benefits and availability of hearing loops.

Summary of Grant: Arrowhead Library System (ALS) will maintain effective and secure connections for its member libraries to the Rock Cat ILS by purchasing adequate WAN bandwidth and upgrading the WAN head-end as needed. ALS will also add to and support the Mobile Makerspace Lab that travels to member libraries for makerspace programs. The makerspace provides the opportunity for member libraries to promote community engagement, provide access, foster new ideas, and encourage exploration. The makerspace gives library patrons and the local community an opportunity to explore and test new technologies and equipment in a safe environment.
