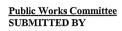

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

AMENDING THE 2016 AIRPORT BUDGET FOR SEWER, WATER, AND ELECTRICAL EXTENSION

In 2008 the airport, with the assistance of funds from the Bureau of Aeronautics, removed one (1) eight and two (2) ten unit t-hangar structures that were beyond repair. This opened up the area to serve single unit private or commercial development. The airport currently has an individual ready to enter into a lease with the airport to erect a 60' x 60' hangar in this area. In the standard lease, the utility clause states that the lessee is responsible for all utility costs, but the lessor is to provide access to sewer and water to the property line of the leased premises. The estimated cost to extend sewer and water is \$9,500. Additionally, Alliant Energy has been upgrading the aging electric services that were installed in the mid-forties. A portion of this cost is the responsibility of the land owner. The extension for the electric service is estimated to cost \$5,000 bringing the total cost to \$14,500.

The Resolution before you gives the airport the appropriation needed to extend these services.

The Department of Justice Asset Forfeiture Program is a nationwide law enforcement initiative that removes the tools of crime from criminal organizations and deprives wrongdoers of the proceeds of their crimes. Federal law authorizes the Attorney General to share federally forfeited property with participating state and local law enforcement agencies.

Equitably shared funds are required to be used by law enforcement agencies for law enforcement purposes only. The intent of the transfer is to enhance law enforcement. It must increase, not supplant the recipient's appropriated operating budget.

For their participation in the program, the Sheriff's Office received funds in the amount of \$6,880. The Sheriff's Office plans to use the funds to purchase six sets of specialized body armor for the Special Investigations Unit.

The body armor consists of front and rear trauma plates, rapid tactical plate carriers, and pouches.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In 2010 the Land Conservation Department commenced with the County Campus site restoration project at Hwy 51 and County Road F, which included the removal of woody invasive species during the summer months of 2010. Restoration activities concluded in this area in 2012 with the establishment of an oak savanna community by establishing grasses and forbs. Ongoing maintenance has become the primary activity in this area.

The second phase of the project was the establishment a prairie community on the 5 acre abandoned agriculture field which was completed in 2014. Ongoing maintenance has become the primary activity in this area.

The Land Conservation Department will continue with ongoing maintenance efforts in the spring of 2016 in both areas with the completion of controlled prairie burns. The local Pheasants Forever burn crew, led by Brian Buenzow will conduct the burns in late spring.

This resolution requests a fund transfer from the ATC Fund account to the LCD budget to facilitate costs associated with completing the tasks associated with the aforementioned restoration projects.

Request for Authorization to Purchase Cisco PoE Switches

The Rock County computer network consists of an infrastructure of Cisco routers and switches that move both data and voice throughout the Ethernet IP network. Computers and IP telephones are connected to the Cisco PoE switches. IP telephones are electronically powered through the computers' connection to a power-over-ethernet (PoE) switch, and also allows us to ensure premium bandwidth and quality of service to the voice traffic on the network.

As older telephones are replaced with newer IP telephones and the need for additional computer and printer connectivity to the network we need to purchase two additional 48-port Catalyst 2960X switches and three stacking modules for the Youth Services Center, the Beloit UW-Extension office, and the Sheriff Jail Expansion area.

These switches and modules are included in the Information Technology 2016 budget and are being purchased from Core BTS, Inc. from Madison, WI on state contract (WI STATE CISCO CONTRACT #50SENT-M11-NETWORKING-01) at a cost of \$9,047.25.
