23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this day of, 2012 does hereby establish a Behavioral Health Redesign Steering Committee to act in an advisory capacity to the County.		
27 28 29 30	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Rock County Board of Supervisors be authorized to appoint up to 20 individuals to serve on the Behavioral Health Redesign Committee, membership of which shall include the following permanent representatives: Rock County Board of Supervisors, Rock County Human Services Department, Rock County Jail, law enforcement, mental health clinics, hospitals		

32 appointing members from the following: Rock County District Attorney's Office, Rock County Public 33 Defender's Office, the twelve step community, JM4C, and minority rights groups such the Latino Service 34 Provider Community, Merrill Community Center, and Beloit Community Fellowships.

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36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair shall appoint up to four citizen members to one-year 37 terms, up to three citizen members to two-year terms, and up to three citizen members to three-year terms. 38

39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair shall appoint a member of the Steering Committee to 40 serve as a temporary chair until such time that the Council establishes a method for electing and elects a 41 chair from its membership.
