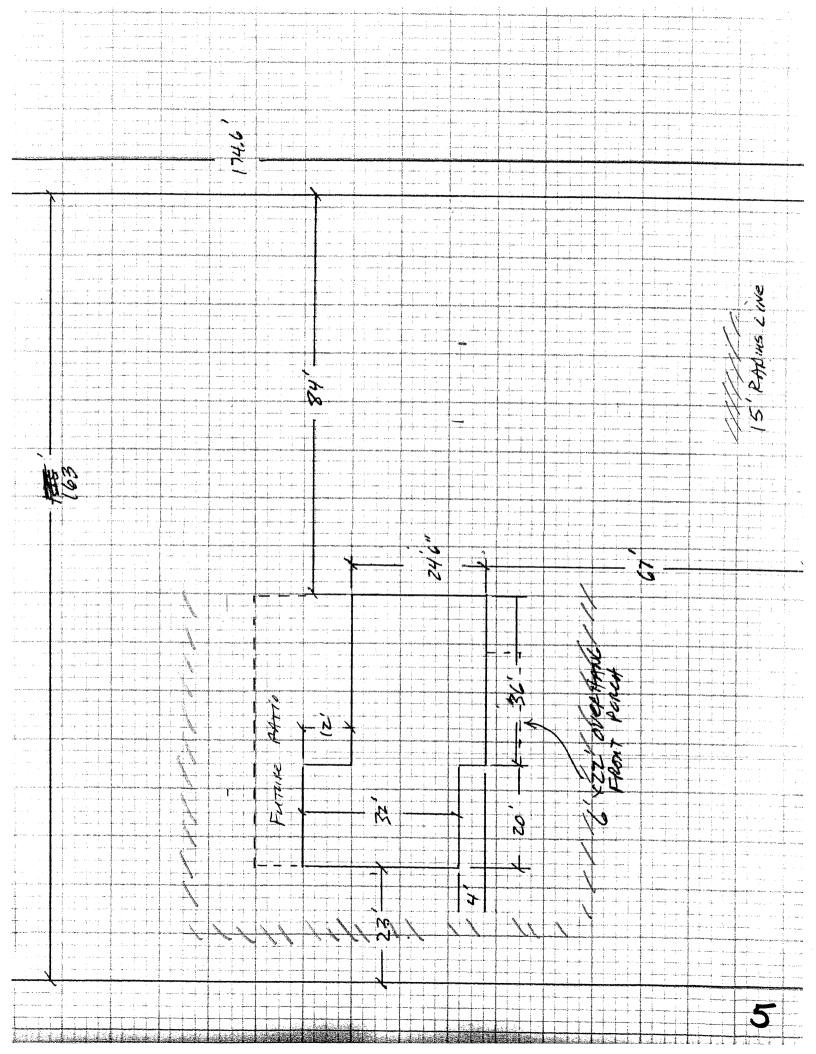

**DATE:** October 18, 2016

#### **Summary:**

The Rock County P&D Staff has received a request from Andrew Gleichauf for an after-the-fact Shoreland Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for filling and land disturbing activities associated with floodproofing a flood damaged residence on a property within the Shoreland Zoning District of the Rock River and in the Floodplain. The site is located at 3413 S River Rd (part of the SW 1/4 of Section 15, Rock Township).

The residence on this property was substantially damaged in the 2008 flood and therefore was required to be removed from the floodplain or floodproofed in compliance with the Floodplain Zoning Ordinance. In general, the Ordinance standards for floodproofing include that the first floor of the structure must be at least two feet above the regional flood elevation, no crawl space or basements floors are permitted below the regional flood elevation and fill must be placed extending fifteen feet around the perimeter of the structure. The property owner at the time of the flood started this floodproofing process but it was not completed. The structure was elevated on a new foundation, but the fill was not place entirely as required. It is our understanding that the property owner at the time ran into financial difficultly and defaulted on the mortgage. The floodproofing project was not completed, therefore the project was not certified as complete by Staff.

Unfortunately, the construction of the new foundation was not done in compliance with the approved permit (and therefore the Ordinance) because, at a minimum, it includes a basement floor below the regional floodplain elevation. Therefore, until this matter is resolved, the structure cannot be certified as floodproofed and not occupied.

The current owner/applicant purchased the property from the mortgage holder in February 2015 after discussing the limitations of the property as whole with Staff, including the deficiencies in floodproofing the foundation. Later in 2015 the applicant deposited fill on the property with the intention of meeting the fill requirements around the perimeter of the structure. The amount of fill deposited exceeds the necessary amount required by Ordinance. No permits were issued at the time for the fill, therefore this application is made by the owner after-the-fact in an effort to resolve the Ordinance violation.

While some fill is required to meet floodproofing standards, it has long been the recommendation of Staff to minimize the amount of fill deposited in the floodplain as to have a limited local and regional impact. In fact, the P&D Committee has acted on a number of after-the-fact Conditional Use Permits in the past where placement of excess fill (or fill not necessary for floodproofing measures) was denied and therefore required

to be removed. One of those denials (and subsequent fill removal projects) was just south of this property at 3501 S River Rd in 2010.

According to Sec. 4.404(3)(A) of the Floodplain Zoning Ordinance residential uses shall meet the following standards:

- 1. The elevation of the lowest floor, excluding the basement or crawlway, shall be at or above the flood protection elevation on fill. The fill shall be one foot or more above the regional flood elevation extending 15 feet beyond the limits of the structure.
- 2. The basement or crawlway floor may be placed at the regional flood elevation if it is floodproofed to the flood protection elevation. No basement or crawlway floor is allowed below the regional flood elevation.

In this location the regional flood elevation is 757.1 feet. The flood protection elevation is 759.1 feet.

Per Section 4.213(3)(B) of Shoreland Zoning Ordinance, the Planning & Development Committee shall state in writing the grounds for granting or denying a conditional use permit. This memo and recommended Conditions of Approval are intended to provide a basis for the decision.

Section 4.213(3)(C) references "Standards Applicable to All Conditional Uses." In deciding a conditional use permit application, the Committee shall evaluate the effect of the proposed use upon (ordinance language is in *italics* below and staff comments are in standard **bold** font):

- 1. The maintenance of safe and healthful conditions. This standard can generally be met if the property is floodproofed according to ordinance standards.
- 2. The prevention and control of water pollution including sedimentation. Erosion and sediment control must be managed properly through the duration of the project to meet this standard.
- 3. Compliance with local floodplain zoning ordinances and opportunity for damage to adjacent properties due to altered surface water drainage. Only the minimum fill necessary to meet floodplain zoning ordinance requirements should be approved and the fill should be placed in a manner to not impact the drainage way in the rear yard area.
- 4. The erosion potential of the site based on the degree and direction of slope, soil type and vegetative cover. The yearly rise of floodwaters will erode the fill material unless it is stabilized as soon as possible after placement. In this case, the ground has been left unstabilized for well over a year.
- 5. The location of the site with respect to existing or future access roads. Not applicable to this project.
- 6. The need of the proposed use for a shoreland location. The owner is planning to complete the repair of a substantially damaged house in the floodplain, which is a permitted use as long as it is floodproofed.
- 7. Its compatibility with uses on adjacent land. The filling and grading work, if not done appropriately, can be incompatible with adjacent land. There is a natural drainage way in the rear yard of many of the properties in this area which serves as a surface water drainage in large rain events and also stores back-water from the Rock River in the first stages of flooding. Placement of fill which blocks this area could impact adjacent lands.
- 8. The amount of liquid and solid wastes to be generated and the adequacy of the proposed disposal system. Not Applicable.
- 9. *Location factors under which:* 
  - a. Domestic uses shall be generally preferred;
  - b. Uses not inherently a source of pollution within the area shall be preferred over uses that are or may be a pollution source:
  - c. Use locations within an area tending to minimize the possibility of pollution shall be preferred over a use locations tending to increase that possibility.

#### Recommendation(s) or Action(s):

P&D Agency Staff recommends approval of the Shoreland Conditional Use Permit to place fill in order to flood proof a residential property with the following conditions:

- 1. Any alteration of surface water drainage must adequately address any potential for impact on adjacent properties or surface waters. For that reason, any fill material that was deposited beyond the extent required to flood proof the residence per Ordinance standards shall be removed from the property. All grading work shall be coordinated with P&D Agency Staff on site for approval prior to and during construction. The permit holder shall ensure that the drainage way in the rear yard remain open to the extent which existed prior to the fill placement.
- 2. The owner is proposing to construct a new detached garage on the property south of the residence. By Ordinance, accessory structures may be placed at the regional flood elevation and do not require the fill fifteen feet around the perimeter as is needed for a principal structure. As an exception to requirement to remove excess fill outlined in Condition #1 above, a new garage may be constructed on fill provided that the garage is constructed in a location reasonably as close to the existing residence as building code will allow and not setback any further from the road than the residence. Doing so will further limit the amount of fill necessary in the floodplain.
- 3. The project shall meet all FEMA Floodplain regulations which are administered through the Rock County Floodplain Zoning Ordinance. This includes properly elevating the structure and filing a Letter of Map Revision based on Fill with FEMA (LOMR-F) to document the floodproofing work.
- 4. The permit holder shall provide information collected by a surveyor or engineer that documents that the elevations and other flood proofing measures are in compliance with the Floodplain Ordinance requirements. Any deficiencies in elevation requirements or general flood proofing standards shall be remedied by the permit holder. The property shall be certified as meeting Floodplain Ordinance Requirements by P&D Staff prior to occupancy.
- 5. Downspouts from existing and proposed structures shall be directed generally to the south and east side of property to allow for the maximum infiltration on the property.
- 6. The smallest amount of bare ground shall be exposed for as short a time as feasible and re-stabilized in a timely fashion with approved Best Management Practices.
- 7. All other necessary permits shall be obtained prior to starting construction.
- 8. This permit expires one year from the date of Committee approval.
