Executive Summary for the Purchase of IP Phones for Human Services

The Human Services Department has developed a plan to replace aging telephones within that department with new IP Phones. This will allow the Human Services staff members to take advantage of the County's Voice-Over-IP telephone system and that system's enhanced technology. The purchase includes:

- 127 Mitel 5330e IP Phones (\$149.29 ea.);
- 127 Mitel Voice Enterprise Business Licenses (\$90.71 ea.);
- 45 Cordless Headset Bundles (\$352.50 ea.), and
- Shipping & Handling

These IP phones will be installed for Human Services staff at Janesville and Beloit office locations.

The total cost of the IP phones, headsets, and shipping is \$46,882.50, and the equipment will be purchased from Enterprise Systems Group using the pricing terms of the State of Wisconsin contract #DC4616.

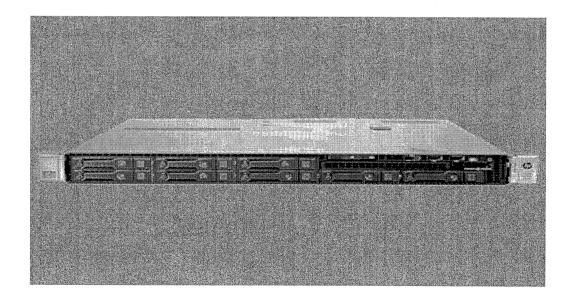
Executive Summary for the Purchase of Network Servers

As part of the 2014 IT Capital Projects budget, this purchase will replace two aging application servers and will be used for establishing the database and business intelligence platform for the next version of the County's HR/Payroll system. The server purchase includes:

- 2 Hewlett Packard ProLiant DL 360 Gen8 Servers (\$7,452.34 ea.);
- Redundant Power Supplies;
- Rack Mounting Components;
- All associated cables, and
- 3 Years Maintenance and Support.

These rack-mounted servers will be located in the data center at the Health Care Center. They will be network-attached and will use the County's Storage Area Network for primary disk storage. These servers will have a useful life to the County of 5-7 years.

The total cost of the 2 Hewlett Packard Servers, rack, and cables is \$14,904.68, and the equipment will be purchased from CDW-G of Vernon Hill, IL using the pricing terms of the State of Wisconsin (WSCA/NASPO contract #15-20400-905.

Medicare Part A pays for short-term stays for residents coming from a qualifying hospital stay to receive skilled nursing and/or therapy services. Reimbursement for each resident is based upon the services provided and reflected on the Minimum Data Set. That information establishes a Resource Utilization Group (RUG) category and sets daily payment.

Over this year, we have seen an increase in both the number of Medicare resident days and the acuity of these residents resulting in higher Medicare expenses and higher Medicare revenue. This budget amendment will increase line items for both Medicare revenue and Medicare expense to reflect these changes. The amendment is budget neutral.

Executive Summary

In 2013 the Council on Aging was awarded a "special projects" grant from the Greater Wisconsin Agency on Aging Resources (GWAAR) to collaborate with the University of Wisconsin Medical School on a Community Academic Aging Research Network project called "Sit Less, Live Better." GWAAR is awarding the Council on Aging additional Title III-D funds this year to continue this research project which tests the effects of reducing sedentary behavior in older adults. The first phase of the project showed remarkable improvement in the well-being of the participants. It is hoped this second testing, with two additional groups, will provide a positive correlation between less sitting time and improved health indicators.
