5. Approval of Minutes of March 22, 2012.

Supervisors Jensen and Fizzell moved the approval of the minutes of March 22, 2012 as presented. ADOPTED as presented by acclamation.

7. <u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements.</u>

Roger Anclam, Town Board Chair for the Town of Turtle, addressed the Board regarding an alternative plan for construction of a new County Road B-T where the current proposal extends Inman Parkway. He stated several factors concerning the Board and residents of the current proposal, including safety of the students at Turner High School. He indicated that proposed alternative of going north on County G to Philhower Road will greatly improve safety of the citizens and businesses currently living on the proposed path, while continuing to provide excellent access to the hospital as well as for the Fire Departments. He mentioned that the current proposal also threatens both prime center pivot irrigated farm land and the 1880's bridge on Lathers Road. He believes this plan serves the City of Beloit but does not fully consider the impact to the items he has already mentioned and does not fully serve all citizens within Rock County. He asked the County Board to consider the proposed route as presented this evening. Supervisor Owens asked if the Towns or the Planning Department have considered going north on County G all the way to Town Line road and putting on ramps there when the highway expansion was done? Mr. Anclam said he would fully support such a proposal.

Tim Guenther, Town Board Supervisor for the Town of Beloit, addressed the Board on the same issue of Inman Parkway Extension to Shopiere Road (County Road S). The Town of Beloit has adopted a resolution opposing the proposed extension of Inman Parkway from South Prairie Avenue (County G) through to Shopiere Road (County Road S). The impact to traffic volumes and pedestrian safety outweigh the perceived economic benefit of the extension. It is the position of the Town Board that similar benefits can be realized with an alternative route utilizing

East Philhower Road, Using East Philhower Road provides access to 190/39, providing similar economic benefits without the potential hazards that Mr. Anclam addressed. Local residential and business traffic on East Philhower lack the volume and congestion of Inman Parkway and pedestrian traffic is minimal. Mr. Guenther expressed that the Town Board of Beloit believes that utilizing the alternate route proposal as shown on the map provided to County Board Supervisors utilizing East Philhower, is a "win-win" scenario for all involved.
