BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Rock County Board of Supervisors is authorized to sing contracts/MOUs for providing CIT training the NAMI Waukesha in an amount not to exceed \$15,000."

Supervisor Wiedenfeld moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Knudson. ADOPTED.

Authorizing Vendor for In-Car Camera System

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this _____ day of ______, 2015 that WatchGuard Video be declared the authorized vendor for the purchase of insquad cameras using the pricing under bid #2014-54.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a purchase order be issued to WatchGuard Video, in the amount of \$10,400, for two in-car cameras.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that payment be made to the vendor upon receipt and acceptance by the Finance Committee."

Commander Knudson said they plan to purchase more as the funds become available.

Supervisor Wiedenfeld asked if they have been helpful. Commander Knudson said they have been very helpful and, from this vendor, have worked great from the start. Mr. O'Leary said they have been helpful to the District Attorney's office as well; they are good back-up for them; this is the way things are going; helpful against complaints against officers; are a bit costly at the front but save money in the end.

<u>Approval for Purchase of Currency Scanner.</u> Supervisor Knudson moved approval to purchase a currency scanner at a cost of \$5,127.25, second by Supervisor Fell.

Commander Knudson said HIDTA funds will be used to purchase the currency scanner ADOPTED.
