PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE COMMITTEE Minutes – February 15, 2016

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Beaver called the meeting of the Public Safety and Justice Committee to order at 4:00 P.M. on February 15, 2016 in Conference Room N-1, Courthouse East.

Adoption of Agenda. Chair Beaver said there was a change to page 1 of the 2015 bills, fourth account down the account number should be 21-2165-2015-63110. Supervisor Fell moved approval of the agenda with this change, second by Supervisor Knudson. ADOPTED.

Adoption of Minutes. Supervisor Wiedenfeld moved approval of the minutes of February 1, 2016 as presented, second by Chair Brill. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications, Announcement, Information.</u> Mr. Friess handed out copies of a new likeness of what John Clinton Doe (JCD) may have looked like at age 16. He said he now believes, after three years and 170 missing person reports later, that JCD may have aged out of the foster care system. He is now in the process of sending out copies of these likenesses to foster care facilities.

<u>Update on 2015 Medical Examiner's Budget.</u> Mr. Irmen said when the 2015 budget was put together they estimated there would be 85 autopsies, and there were actually 128 autopsies done. Mr. Irmen said the Dane County ME's Office said they would do an extra ten autopsies at no charge and that the transfer request in the packet is for the remaining 33 autopsies and additional lab work done in 2015. He said it is impossible to estimate the number of autopsies when someone else was in charge previously. Mr. Irmen indicated that he would be monitoring the cases in 2016.

Captain Christiansen said they had requested the previous Coroner's Office to do autopsies in the past and they were not done. He said the Sheriff's Office is very happy with the Medical Examiner's Office.
