## PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE COMMITTEE Minutes – November 17, 2014

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Beaver called the meeting of the Public Safety and Justice Committee to order at 4:00 P.M. on November 17, 2014 in Conference Room N-1 Courthouse - East.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications, Announcement, Information.</u> A Committee member requested at a prior meeting an overview of the Sonic Boom music festival. Mr. Osborne reported the Sonic Boom music event went well. This was the first event they have held at the Southern Wisconsin Regional Airport and had over 7,000 people in attendance. A number of non-profit, charities benefited from the event, as well as about \$28,000 being spent in the community. Mr. Osborne said everyone seemed happy with the outcome and how it ran.

Mr. Farrell handed out copies of a news release, which will be going out later that day, on the John "Clinton" Doe case and an artist sketch from an FBI forensic artist. The plan is to get the sketch out to as many organizations and law enforcement agencies as quickly as possible.

Mr. Farrell said things are lining up for next year on a suicide prevention coalition and he should be bringing something to the Committee soon.
