"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this _____ day of _____, 2014 does hereby authorize the purchase of a one acre parcel of property from Hendricks Commercial Properties, LLC located near the intersection of Tower and Artisian Roads in the City of Edgerton, WI, for the sum of \$30,000, plus closing costs; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Board Chair and the County Clerk be authorized to execute legal documents related to the sale transaction on behalf of the County; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following contingencies will have been met prior to closing: 1) the results of a soils investigation of the subject property finding the property suitable to construct a communications tower, and 2) approval(s) from the City of Edgerton."

Supervisor Beaver moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Knudson. ADOPTED.

<u>Authorizing Purchase of Motorola CAD Software Upgrade for 911</u> Communications Center

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 27th day of March, 2014 that a Purchase Order be issued to Motorola in an amount not to exceed \$294,221 to contract with Rock County for the purchase of the PremierOne Mobile Data software.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this 27th day of March, 2014, does allow for milestone payments to the vendor upon approval of the I.T. Director."
