#### 10.A. Update on Recruitment Process for County Administrator

Human Resources Director, David O'Connell, explained to the Board that the finalists were named this past Monday and have since received attention in the press. The County has been working through a search process to replace Craig Knutson who will be retiring effective August 2. He reminded Board members that a special county board meeting that will be properly noticed will be held at the Pontiac Convention Center on Thursday, May 15<sup>th</sup> beginning at 5:45pm. This meeting gives each Board member the informal chance to mingle with the finalists until 6:30pm. A community event will begin at 6:30pm and run until 8pm where each finalist will give a brief introduction of themselves and then the group will be divided into 3 smaller groups to gain a more informal experience with the finalist. Participants will be given comment cards to fill out and leave for use by the County Board Staff Committee. On Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, the County Board Staff Committee will conduct 2<sup>nd</sup> interviews with the 3 finalists and they are expected to make a recommendation of a final candidate no later than Tuesday, May 27<sup>th</sup>. The timeline includes a resolution to enter into a contract with the selected candidate at the County Board Staff Committee meeting on June 10<sup>th</sup> and then action by the entire County Board at its general meeting on Thursday, June 12<sup>th</sup>. Craig Knutson is retiring August 1<sup>st</sup> and it is hopeful that the new County Administrator will have a minimum of 3 weeks of overlap with Craig to train and shadow.
