7. <u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements</u>

Tony Farrell, Sr., Janesville, addressed the Board to give an update on some of his volunteer projects. He announced that the Special Touch Ministries Summer Camp will be held June 23-27 this year. Also, FreedomFest will be held this year on June 28<sup>th</sup> on the grounds of New Life Assembly of God from 10am to 10pm. This festival is free to the public and is sponsored by more than 20 churches countywide. More information on this event can be found at <u>http://freedomfestnewlife.com/</u>. Mr. Farrell explained to the new supervisors that he is the

volunteer director of the Suicide Prevention Network for Rock County under the supervision of the Rock County Coroner's office, and he is proud to say that the efforts of this program have shown success in both a decline in suicides as well as in increase in documented saves. He finished by explaining that as a deputy coroner, he is working with schools to discuss safety and prevention issues such as seatbelt safety, anti-bullying, helmet safety, the dangers of texting while driving and other issues.

Supervisor Heidenreich invited Supervisors to participate in the upcoming MS Walk happening in Janesville at Palmer Park on Saturday, May 4<sup>th</sup>. Check in is at 9am and walk begins at 10am. In support of this event he invited them to attend a fundraiser for "Team Droz" at Macs pizza shack on Wednesday, April 30<sup>th</sup> from 4-8pm.

Supervisor Kraft reminded the Board and the public that Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup> at the Rock County Fairgrounds, there will be a rabies clinic for pets to receive \$10 vaccinations. This effort is sponsored by the Rock County Board of Health and Friends of Noah. She also shared that in honor of earth day this week, the Rock County Drug Collection Program collected 4329.5 pounds of prescription drugs in 2013. This program continues to grow and show success by properly disposing of drugs that can fall into the wrong hands and/or harm the environment.
