- 1) Grocery store shopping cart handles and cart seats.
- 2) Children's playgrounds, swings, jungle gyms and other equipment.
- 3) Public restroom sink taps, faucet handles, soap dispensers.
- 4) Office telephones, desks, and computer keyboards.
- 5) Restaurant table surfaces and high chairs.
- 6) Library countertops, surfaces and computer keyboards.
- 7) Cruise ship handrails and restrooms.
- 8) Shopping malls and airport escalator handrails.

Use disinfecting wipes on surfaces before you touch these types of surfaces and/or hand sanitizers after you have touched any of these types of surfaces.
