FINANCE COMMITTEE Minutes – August 16, 2012

Review of 2012 \$7.3 Million Capital Improvement Debt Issue — Carol Wirth, President, Wisconsin Public Finance Professionals, LLC. Ms. Wirth handed out her Report on 2012 Financing — Rock Haven and Highway Projects- \$7.3 Million G.O. Promissory Notes. Ms. Wirth said, as we are approaching the completion of the Rock Haven project, it is important to list another project in case the funds are not completely spent otherwise the funds could only be used to pay interest. She went over the capital projects the County Board approved for 2012 borrowing. Ms. Wirth went over the Source and Application of the Funds; the 2012 Financing Details; Estimated Debt Service Schedule, trying to make the last two years callable; Estimated Pricing Summary; and the Combined Existing Debt (2011 and 2012).
