Veterans Services – John Solis

<u>Changes at Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs</u> Mr. Solis informed the Committee that Mr. Ken Black has been appointed and things are changing, hopefully claims will be handled sooner.

<u>State Benefits</u> Mr. Solis said some of the Wisconsin GI Bill law is not understood so they are going back to make sure things are crystal clear. He said it is estimated the Trust Fund will be out of money by the end of 2011. There is talk of reinstating a liquor tax to replenish the fund.

Discussion on the need for institutionalized care and that there is no place to go.

<u>Semi-Annual Report – Attendance at Conventions/Conferences.</u> The Committee accepted reports from the Council on Aging and Veterans Services and directed they be placed on file.

<u>Committee Requests and Motions.</u> Chair Wiedenfeld said after RSVP has moved into their new location the Committee should meet there, possibly March or April.

Mr. Solis said he will be taking part in the final de-mobilization briefings at Fort McCoy on the 25th.

Ms. Lubben said she has put the 2009 Transportation Report together and they had a 41% increase over 2008, providing over 10,000 additional rides.
