Voter Assistance Initiative and Amending Register of Deeds Budget

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this ______ day of ______, 2012 approves the Rock County Voter Assistance Initiative Program modeled after the Milwaukee County program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Register of Deeds shall provide free birth certificates for the purpose of obtaining a state issued ID card for voting purposes only, with the following rules/limitations:

- Individuals seeking a free birth certificate need to state in writing that the birth certificate is being obtained for the sole purpose of obtaining a state issued ID card for voting purposes.
- Individuals will need to fill out a Birth Certificate Application.
- Individuals must be of voting age as of the November 2012 election.
- Only one free birth record will be given per applicant.
- Free birth records will be stamped: FOR VOTER ID USE ONLY.
- Will need to present acceptable forms of identification per state statute.
- Eligible persons must be born in Rock County and a resident of Rock County (i.e., plan to vote in a Rock County election).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Register of Deeds Budget be amended as follows to provide up to 200 free birth certificates for voter identification:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that once the 200 free certificates have been issued in 2012, the program will be terminated unless extended by action of the Rock County Board of Supervisors."

Supervisor Kraft moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Diestler.

Supervisor Kraft moved to add "BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution will become effective when a court of competent jurisdiction determines Voter ID is required", second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

Mr. Byrnes, Ms. Borlick handed out maps and tables. Ms. Stottler explained that when the State first drafted the boundaries they used census block information, which they found out recently does not match with the counties information. The State has asked that the census block information be removed from the ordinances and to use the more accurate county information to help alleviate possible future problems. Ms. Stottler asked the Committee what they thought would be most helpful at County Board. The Committee felt the table would be the more helpful and less confusing than the maps.

ADOPTED.

<u>Discussion on Investment Advisor.</u> Ms. Oja informed the Committee that Cutwater is still working on obtaining a representative in Wisconsin. Mr. Kuglitsch and Ms. Oja said the RFP had required a representative in Wisconsin, which Cutwater had at the time, but the contract does not state this. She asked the Committee if they felt the County should go out for RFP, or continue with Cutwater until the end of 2013. The Committee said they are happy with Cutwater at this time and asked that staff discuss if a representative in Wisconsin is still necessary with so much being done electronically now. Staff will discuss this, bring the results back to the Committee, and a decision will then be made at the end of 2013 to either go out for RFP or to use the renew option until 2016.

Report on Cash Balances and Investments. Ms. Oja updated the Committee on cash balances and investments as of February 29, 2012 and handed out the County Sales Tax Receipts for February 2012.

<u>Adjournment</u>. Supervisor Diestler moved adjournment at 8:40 A.M., second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.
