PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING

This mailer is part of the public involvement meeting to discuss the replacement of the bridge carrying CTH J over Turtle Creek. The intent of the meeting is to present information about the proposed project and to gather input from you.

PROJECT PURPOSE AND NEED

The purpose of this project is to replace the CTH J bridge in Rock County. The bridge is located at the crossing of Turtle Creek, approximately 0.1 miles north of the junction with CTH S. The existing bridge needs to be replaced because it is structurally deficient.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed improvement will replace the three-span continuous steel deck girder bridge with a new 30' wide three-span concrete haunch slab bridge structure. The roadway and bridge will have 11' travel lanes with 4' paved shoulders between the guardrail and bridge railings.

Work included will be bridge removal, new bridge construction, grading, placement of crushed aggregate base course and asphalt pavement, guardrail, erosion control, and minor landscaping. The project will temporarily impact adjacent private right-of-way by the Shopiere Tap in order to tie in the new grading.

TRAFFIC CONTROL

During construction of the project, the bridge will be closed to traffic. The closure is anticipated to last approximately $2\frac{1}{2}$ months during the summer and fall of 2022. Entrances will likely experience some disruption for a few days but will remain open.

ENVIRONMENTAL

Wetlands will be impacted on the project. Necessary permits for wetland and in-stream impacts will be completed with the DNR and US Army Corps of Engineers.

Turtle Creek is classified as warm water stream with a diverse fishery, and as an Exceptional Resources Water due to the presence of threatened and endangered resources. Work in the river may <u>not</u> occur from February 28th through June 16th to protect the fish population.
