FINANCE COMMITTEE October 1, 2009

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Mawhinney called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, October 1, 2009, in Conference Room N-1 on the fifth floor of the Rock County Courthouse-East.

<u>Committee Members Present</u>. Supervisors Mawhinney, Kraft, Beaver, Diestler, Podzilni.

Committee Members Excused. None.

<u>Staff Members Present.</u> Jeff Smith, Finance Director; Craig Knutson, County Administrator; Vicki Brown, Treasurer; Mickey Crittenden, Information Technology Director; Dave Sudmeier, Health Care Center Controller; Ben Coopman, Public Works Director; Jeff Kuglitsch, Corporation Counsel (at 8:30 A.M.).

Others Present: None.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>. Chair Mawhinney advised a transfer is being added for the Finance Director. Supervisor Podzilni moved approval of the agenda with this addition, second by Supervisor Diestler. ADOPTED as amended.

<u>Committee Review and Approval of Per Meeting Allowances</u>. Supervisor Beaver moved approval of Per Meeting Allowances in the amount of \$17,234.59, second by Supervisor Diestler. ADOPTED.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Supervisor Diestler moved approval of the minutes of September 17, 2009 as presented, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements</u>. Ms. Brown distributed information on the Public Auction, 9:00 A.M., Friday, October 9, 2009. She advised the City of Beloit purchased all of their properties. There are currently five properties going to the Auction.

Ms. Brown advised she is on the Wisconsin Counties Association Taxation and Finance Committee, representing Wisconsin County Treasurers.

Mr. Knutson said they are waiting for the tax levy limit work sheets from the State and do not anticipate receiving them for another week and a half. New statutory provisions allow municipalities, including counties, to calculate their tax levy limit using the difference between the 2007 allowable levy and the actual 2007 levy as an addition to the current 3% levy limit for the 2009 payable 2010 tax levy. This provision would allow the County to increase its 2009 payable 2010 tax levy by 8.13% compared to last year's actual levy. Mr. Knutson said cost shifting and State Aid cuts are coming in higher than anticipated - \$1.8 to \$2 million rather than \$1.5 million as previously thought. Mr. Smith said the State will also be delaying payments on Human Services contract payments. Rather than receiving 1/12 of the contract costs per month, as has been done previously, the County will receive 25% of the contract costs through the first six months of 2010.

Mr. Knutson advised they are looking into having a third party administrator for the health insurance plan.

Mr. Smith reminded the Committee that the budget will be presented to the County Board on October 8th. He proposed the Finance Committee review of budget requests be held on Wednesday, October 28th, 7:30 A.M. The Committee was in agreement.

Mr. Smith said he received the draft report of the OPEB update. It has been reviewed by the auditors and Human Resources. The bill, which covers a two-year period, is in the agenda.
