PRESERVING THE STATE OF WISCONSIN WORKING LANDS INITIATIVE AND PURCHASE OF AGRICULTURAL CONSERVATION EASEMENTS (PACE) PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Rock County Board of Supervisors supports the protection and preservation of productive agricultural lands in the State of Wisconsin and Rock County; and,
- WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin adopted the Farmland Preservation Program (FPP) in 1977, with the FPP serving as a national model for protecting and preserving productive agricultural lands and Rock County began participation in the FPP in 1979, and has maintained its participation to the present day; and,
 - WHEREAS, as a result of the vision and efforts of former DATCP Secretary Rod Nilsestuen, a Working Lands Steering Committee, consisting of twenty-six (26) State of Wisconsin residents representing various parties interested in and affected by farmland preservation in the State, was formulated in 2005 to develop recommendations to modify and improve the FPP, to ensure the FPP adapt to changes in land use planning and development trends and patterns, and to provide for a more comprehensive approach to protection and preservation of productive agricultural lands in the State; and,
 - WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin adopted the recommendations of the Working Lands Steering Committee, entitled the Working Lands Initiative (WLI), as part of the 2009 Act 28, Biennium Budget Bill; and,
 - WHEREAS, a specific component of the WLI, the State's PACE Program, provides funding to purchase agricultural conservation easements, to ensure protection and preservation of productive agricultural lands throughout the State; and,
 - WHEREAS, the Rock County Board of Supervisors recently adopted the Rock County PACE Program, a Program designed to purchase agricultural conservation easements in Rock County, working in cooperation with local governments in the County, enhancing the County's quality of life by building consensus towards a regional vision, including preservation of agricultural land, the agricultural economy, and the County's rural character, and responsible growth and development in appropriate areas; and,
 - WHEREAS, the Wisconsin PACE program is in its infancy and given time will expand into other parts of the state as the initiative is better understood; and;
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Rock County Board of Supervisors, duly assembled this

 Line day of Now, 2011, requests the State of Wisconsin to preserve the Working Lands
 Initiative, the FPP, the PACE Program, the AEA Program and the Working Lands Fund in their current
 form, and not modify or amend said Initiative, Programs, or Fund,
