Committee Requests and Motions.

<u>Discussion of National and State Budgets.</u> Ms. Lubben provided a handout of Fiscal Year 2018 Proposed President budget requests for Labor-HHS Appropriations. Supervisor Schulz is concerned with the cuts that are being proposed. She spoke with Senator Baldwin's office. They suggested to wait and see how this plays out with Senate and the House. Ms. Lubben said the cuts to the State Health Insurance Assistance Program would have a direct effect on our County as it helps pay for our Elder Benefit Specialist positions. Supervisor Schulz would like to hear from Bob Harlow, RSVP, on how these proposed cuts would affect his budget.

Accreditation Training Changes for Veterans Service Office. Mr. Solis reported to the committee that accreditation training requirements have changed whereas, he and his employees only have to attend one conference per year to keep their accreditation. He will have all of his employees from both offices attend the training at one time. Their offices will be closed for one week. This will save money as he had already budgeted for two conferences. His newest staff member, Paul, will be attending his initial training in Milwaukee next week. CVSO Association is looking to host the National Conference in 2021 in Madison. The new VA secretary has made changes to the block grant. It will go back to how it was previously disbursed. The committee asked Mr. Solis if the Beloit sign was ever installed. Yes, they have a nice sign on the door with the logo and hours and the Eclipse Center will soon be installing a power door to their entrance.

Ms. Lubben said the Council on Aging is in need of a sign as well. Supervisor Owens asked Ms. Lubben to get him the specs for the sign and he will assist with this. Supervisor Zajac said Facilities Management is very efficient with requests.

<u>Adjournment.</u> Supervisor Pleasant moved adjournment at 4:50 P.M., second by Supervisor Owens. ADOPTED.
