# Awarding Pharmacy Services Contract to Mallatt's Homecare Pharmacy

# **Executive Summary**

The Human Services Department serves approximately three hundred individuals annually with serious and persistent mental illness and co-occurring disorders through the Community Support Program (CSP) and Outpatient Clinics. The Department assists a significant portion of these clients with obtaining their medication through coordination with a designated pharmacy that fills prescriptions and delivers dose packed medications to the program clinics. An established relationship with a designated pharmacy allows for improved coordination of care and medication management for individuals living in the community who are served by these programs.

The Department issued a Request for Qualifications from pharmacies to provide medications and coordinated medication management services to the Community Support Program and designated Outpatient Clients. An evaluation team independently and thoroughly reviewed and scored submitted proposals, then sent follow up questions and conducted interviews with the two highest scoring proposing pharmacies. Through this process, qualifications have been thoroughly evaluated and Mallatt's Homecare Pharmacy of Madison, WI was given the highest rating based on their proposal, responses to written follow-up questions and in-person interview.

There will be no dollar amount assigned to a contract with Mallatt's. The contracted Pharmacy receives compensation through billing a client's insurance for the costs of their medications. For a select small group of uninsured clients, HSD will purchase medications from Mallatt's who will invoice HSD for those costs on a monthly basis.

For clients living with serious and persistent mental illness in the community, medication management and adherence is often an essential element of successful treatment and is a primary support for clients' ability to remain in the community.
