### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

From time to time it is necessary to take service contracts out for bid to ensure that the County is receiving the best pricing and service that it can achieve. In furtherance of this effort, Rock County issued an RFP for Benefit Consulting Services. Rock County was looking for a Benefit Consultant that would assist with Strategic Insurance Placement, Compliance Risk Management, Actuarial Review, Analysis of Market Trends and Due Diligence, and Employee Benefits Administration.

Five responsive proposals were received and narrowed down by the raters to four competitive proposals. Interviews were conducted with the four finalists. M3 Insurance was determined to yield the greatest return on our investment of all the proposals submitted.
