## **2013 Grant Application of s.85.21 Specialized Transportation Assistance Program for Counties.**

Chair Thomas opened the Public Hearing at 4:11 P.M. and asked if anyone present wished to speak. No one was present to speak. Chair Thomas closed the Public Hearing at 4:12 P.M.

Approval to Close Olympian Village Congregate Nutrition Site. Ms. Lubben explained to the Committee the lack of funding, low participation (January, they served 16 meals a day and for September, it is down to 11 meals per day), and the proximity of another congregate site, Grinnell Hall, 6 blocks away as reasons for this closing. The closing date is December 28, 2012 and the savings total \$11,474, which is the salary for the site manager.

Supervisor Brown moved approval to close Olympian Village Congregate Nutrition Site, second by Supervisor Howland. ADOPTED.

#### **Budget Review**

<u>Council on Aging</u> Ms. Lubben said her requests pretty much mirror Mr. Knutson's recommendations. There is a title change for the Benefits Specialist to the Elderly Benefits Specialist.

**Heritage Rock County** No one was present from Heritage Rock County.

**Retired Senior Volunteer Program** No one was present from RSVP.

Senior Services of Rock County

No one was present from Senior Services of Rock County.

<u>U.W. Rock County</u> No one was present from UW Rock County.

<u>Veterans Service Office</u> Mr. Solis mentioned the \$8,025 decrease is the result of staff turnover, health insurance status change from family to single, and a lower wage rate than the previous employee.

Mr. Solis mentioned he is the President of the County Veterans Service Officers Association of Wisconsin (CVSOAW). CVSOAW is comprised of CVSO's from 72 counties and Tribal Veterans Service Officers from 11 Native American Tribes throughout Wisconsin. Rock County will host the State Association conference next fall.
