- Monitor the expenditures of transportation funds being expended on transportation services for the elderly and disabled in Rock County;
- Review passenger transportation plans for Rock County;
- Review and comment on county aid applications under s.85.21, Stats.;
- Review and comment on capital assistance applications under s.85.22, Stats;
- Act as an informational resource for local transportation providers regarding the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 USC 12101 et seq.;
- Act on requests by local public bodies to be designated as coordinators of transportation services for elderly and disabled persons for the purpose of becoming eligible for assistance under the federal sec. 5310 program;
- Develop and administer a county Transportation Coordination Plan; and,

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rock County Council on Aging, along with other transportation providers located within the County, applies for various federal and state transportation grants that fund transportation services for the elderly and people with disabilities. Federal regulations state that these projects must be derived from a "locally developed, coordinated public transit-human services transportation plan" as a condition of funding.

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation also requires that s.85.21 Elderly and Disabled Transportation Assistance to Counties applications be reviewed by a Transportation Coordinating Committee. State statues are in place to provide guidance as to composition and duties of this committee.

A Transportation Coordinating Committee has been meeting for the past several years. This resolution formalizes the Committee and ensures applications for funding meet this requirement.

No county tax levy is required.
