AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT THAT CREATES THE MARSH COUNTRY HEALTH ALLIANCE COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY BOARD CHAIR TO APPOINT A COMMISSION MEMBER

- WHEREAS, Dodge County currently owns and operates a facility known as Clearview Long-Term Care and Rehabilitation ("Clearview") which, among other things, is a skilled nursing facility and facility for the developmentally disabled; and,
- 5 WHEREAS, Rock County anticipates a need to place Rock County residents in Clearview for the foreseeable future; and,
- WHEREAS, Dodge County currently provides funding necessary to operate Clearview at a rate that exceeds the Medicaid reimbursement rate, thus creating a situation where Dodge County is contributing county tax levy funds for the care of Rock County (and other county) residents; and,
- WHEREAS, it is in Rock County's best interest to ensure the continued financial viability of Clearview as an appropriate placement alternative, given the high costs associated with potential placement at other facilities, including the state centers; and,
- WHEREAS, Dodge County and other counties, including Adams, Columbia, Grant, Green, Iowa, Jefferson, Ozaukee, Rock, Sauk and Waukesha have studied the possibility of creating an intergovernmental commission, pursuant to Wis. Stat. 66.0301(3), to be known as Marsh Country Health Alliance Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission"); and,
- WHEREAS, the creation of the Commission would allow Clearview to continue its operations with funding provided from all of the counties that are members of the Commission; and,
- WHEREAS, the legal authority and goals of the Commission are set forth in the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement; and,
- WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement, Dodge County shall contract with the Commission for the purposes of: (1) leasing a portion of Clearview to the Commission and, (2) providing for the administration, maintenance and operation of the leased portion of Clearview; and,
- WHEREAS, the goals of the Commission, as set forth in the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement, are in accordance with the philosophy and public policy objectives of Rock County; and,
- WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. 66.0301 and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement require each participating county to execute the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement before the Agreement is effective and binding; and,
- WHEREAS, it is the intent of this resolution to authorize Rock County to create and become a member of the Commission and authorize a Rock County Board Supervisor, appointed in accordance with Rock County rules and procedures, to finalize and execute an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement creates the Marsh Country Health Alliance Commission. In essence, the Marsh Country Health Alliance is a multi-jurisdictional entity that will: 1) lease the Dodge County Nursing Home known as Clearview; (2) contract with Dodge County to manage the facility, and (3) provide a financial mechanism to assess member counties for housing residential placements in Clearview. At present there are 11 counties, including Rock, that are considering joining the Alliance.

It would be advantageous for Rock County to join the Alliance so that it has another placement alternative to expensive state institutes such as Mendota and Winnebago. Rock County is a member of the Mississippi Valley Health Service Corporation. Membership allows the County to send difficult placements to Lakeview Health Center in La Crosse for roughly \$40/day over the Medical Assistance rate. Lakeview is at capacity, thus finding an open bed can be a challenge. Joining the Marsh Country Health Alliance gives us another option to make cost effective placements (approximately \$47/day over the Medical Assistance rate) that is only 60 miles from Janesville.

Passage of this resolution authorizes Rock County to join the Alliance. The \$5,000 initial membership fee will be paid out of the 2010 Human Services Budget. The resolution also authorizes the County Board Chair to appoint a commission member (subject to Board approval). Upon notification that the formation of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement has been approved by other participating counties, the County Clerk, appointed commission member and the Corporation Council are authorized to enter the Agreement.

The Marsh Country Health Alliance wishes to hold its formulation meeting on May 24th. The Rock County commission member would attend that meeting as this County's voting member. Action items at that meeting include appointing a Board of Directors, electing officers, and entering a lease agreement with Dodge County for Clearview. The goal is to have a state approved operating license by July 1, 2010.
