FINANCE COMMITTEE Minutes – December 19, 2019

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Mawhinney called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, December 19, 2019 in Conference Room N-1, Fifth Floor, Rock County Courthouse-East.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>. Supervisor Fox moved approval of the agenda as presented, second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.

<u>Approval of Minutes – December 5, 2019</u>. Supervisor Beaver moved approval of the minutes of December 5, 2019 as presented, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements. None.

Report from PFM Asset Management. Ms. Walters handed out the Rock County Core Investment Performance Review for the Quarter Ended September 30, 2019. She briefly went over the comparisons of the S&P 500 and the 10-year Treasury 2018 versus 2019; there was a 27.6% return on the S&P 500 in 2019; the Federal funds are holding steady at the December 13, 2019 meeting; consumer confidence is up; the U.S. unemployment rate is down to 3.5%; businesses are cautious and CEO confidence is down; and there were various global concerns in 2019. Ms. Walters said, in summary, our portfolio has good credit quality, and our maturity distribution is mostly between one and five years, with an average yield of 2.25%. She said our current yield is at 1.76%. Ms. Walters said our portfolio performance had a 5.41% return, and our return since inception is 2.24%. She went over our issuer distribution and said it has a good distribution with no large sums in any on area.

Transfers and Appropriations. None.

<u>Review of Payments.</u> The Committee accepted the reports.

Review of Payments Over \$10,000. The Committee accepted the reports.

Update, Discussion and Possible Action.

<u>Greenway Point Subdivision</u> Ms. Roettger informed the Committee she had an inquiry on the properties and asked if the opening bid could be lowered.

Mr. Greenlee said he reached out to Mr. Godek, City of Janesville, and has not heard back from him yet.

Ms. Roettger said the person making the inquiry is aware they have to pay the delinquent taxes.

Supervisor Podzilni moved to lower the opening bid amounts to the suggested opening bid amounts Ms. Roettger provided, second by Supervisor Fox.

Supervisor Fox said these are all fair prices on the lots.

ADOPTED.

Discussion on where to list the properties. The Committee agreed to have Ms. Roettger list them on the County website until the first of the year and then to list them on the online surplus auction website if they have not sold, as they cannot be listed on both sites at the same time.

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS AND/OR NOTES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,230,000 PAGE 2

FISCAL NOTE:

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize expenditures from the 2020 deferred finance budget appropriations prior to actual debt issuance. The 2020 budgeted capital projects are estimated to cost \$3,230,000 (plus issuance costs) for Highway Road Construction Capital Projects. If the County adopts this resolution, the project costs and issuance costs will be included in a subsequent resolution that authorizes the issuance of General Obligation Bonds and/or Notes.

LEGAL NOTE:

This is only an initial resolution. Pursuant to sec. 67.05(10), Stats., the County Board, before issuing any contemplated long-term debt, must adopt a resolution levying a direct, annual tax sufficient in an amount to pay for the express purpose of paying the interest on such bonds as it falls due, and also to pay and discharge the principal thereof at maturity. That will happen at a later date.

A majority vote is necessary to adopt this resolution. However, a three-fourths vote of the "members-elect" would avoid any potential issue relative to the debt levy rate limit.

Executive Summary

The Rock County Hazardous Materials Response Team responded to two hazardous materials releases in 2019. Under Wisconsin State Statute 323.71 and Rock County Ordinance Section 2.508, responding agencies, including the Rock County Hazardous Materials Response Team, are permitted to recover expenses incurred while responding to an emergency involving a release or potential release of hazardous materials.

The Emergency Management Division, of the Rock Count Sheriff's Office, will invoice the two responsible parties for expenses incurred while responding to the hazardous materials releases. The Emergency Management Division will reimburse the Janesville Fire Department's Hazmat Team for their portion of the expenses incurred.

The Sheriff's Office's budget will be amended to grant spending authority to reimburse the Janesville Fire Department's Hazmat Team.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rock County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) operates under Rock County Emergency Management through state funding received annually to cover operating costs. Annually, Rock County Emergency Management submits for the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) Planning Grant under Wisconsin Emergency Management Guidance. As required under the EPCRA Planning Grant, Rock County Emergency Management serves the LEPC in accordance with Wisconsin requirements, including the control of the annual LEPC budget. The 2020 LEPC budget operates on the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) schedule, thus operating from October 1st, 2019 to September 30th, 2020.

The State of Wisconsin has awarded the Rock County LEPC \$38,083 to operate in the 2020 FFY. State aid received through the award is used to sustain LEPC operations and manage offsite facility plans for Rock County facilities and farms that are in possession of hazardous chemicals.
