# APPROVE RELOCATION ORDER FOR CTH M INTERSECTION RECONFIGURATION PROJECT

The design process for the reconstruction of CTH M from Countyline Road to USH 14 has identified the need for additional right of way or easements to accommodate some cross drainage pipes. It is required by Statute that the County Board pass a Relocation Order as the first legal step in the process. This resolution amends a Relocation Order first approved by the County Board in 2011 at the intersection area of Countyline Road and CTH M. The amended Relocation Order expands the area of coverage to the south to allow for the drainage pipe work.

This resolution adopts the Revised Relocation Order and delegates responsibility for implementation to the Public Works Committee and Director of Public Works.

Description of Termini of Project:

The same being sheet 4.1 of said plat and described in permanent limited easements for drainage and erosion control also associated with said highway project.
