Authorizing Renewal of the Microsoft Enterprise Agreement

In April of 2014 per Resolution 14-5A-018, Rock County and the Information Technology Department entered into an Enterprise Agreement with the Microsoft Corporation as part of the Wisconsin State Contract for network infrastructure and desktop application software. Terms of the agreement require a renewal every three years to maintain the favorable pricing and most current software versions offered as part of the agreement. This agreement allows the County to keep all of the County's desktop applications on the most up-to-date software available as well as keep all network components on the same platform. This strategy allows for a more streamlined approach to software management and allows I.T. staff a uniform suite of products for not only Microsoft software, but also software supported by Microsoft and utilized by the county such as the Citrix remote desktop software which has been an integral part of the County's remote workforce initiative during COVID-19. In addition to uniformity and standardization, this software agreement also reduces risk to the County's computer infrastructure by removing the need to support multiple platforms which would require multiple security patches as implemented.

The Microsoft Enterprise agreement will span the budget years 2020 through 2023 with three equal payments of \$402,392.67 as put forth in the agreement procured from Microsoft via CDW-G and the state of Wisconsin contract # 505ENT-M16-VARSOFTWARE-04.
