WHEREAS, such alternate members would be appointed by the Chair of the Board of Supervisors and confirmed by the Board of Supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the ability of such alternate members to participate in the deliberations of the Transportation Coordinating Committee with the rights to vote and serve as part of a quorum is contingent upon the confirmation of their appointment to that role by the Rock County Board of Supervisors.
