1	WHEREAS, the Human Services Department, Community Support Program (CSP) Psychiatric
2	Technicians deliver daily medications to consumers living with mental illness in the community so as to

WHEREAS, medication delivery services are a means of improving quality of life for consumers and reducing costs associated with institutional stays and supported living arrangements; and,

WHEREAS, an increasing need for medication deliveries for CSP clients has resulted in inadequate staff resources to deliver medications to clients in a timely manner; and,

WHEREAS, the addition of two .4 FTE Psychiatric Technicians to deliver medications will meet the current client need and will result in reduced overtime costs for current staff; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of adding two .4 FTE Psychiatric Technicians for 4 months in 2018 is \$8,995; and,

WHEREAS, adequate funding exists in the 2018 CSP budget to cover this expense due to current staff vacancies.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Creating Two .4 FTE Psychiatric Technician Positions

The Human Services Department's Community Support Program (CSP) Psychiatric Technicians deliver daily medications to consumers living with mental illness in the community to support their ability to live independently. These services improve the quality of life for consumers and reduce the costs associated with institutional stays and supported living arrangements. The Department currently has three .4 FTE Psychiatric Technicians dedicated to medication delivery, but an increasing number of clients living in the community and in need of medication has resulted in the part-time staff working extra hours and making late deliveries. It is important that deliveries be made in a timely manner to ensure the effectiveness of the medications. The addition of two .4 FTE Psychiatric Technicians will meet the current client need and will allow the existing staff to work within their budgeted hours, reducing overtime costs.

The cost of adding two .4 FTE Psychiatric Technicians for 4 months in 2018 is \$8,995. There is adequate funding in the CSP budget to cover this expense due to current staff vacancies.
