TO AMEND SECTION 18.102 OF THE ROCK COUNTY PERSONNEL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, a person's sexual orientation is distinct from a person's gender identity and expression; and,

WHEREAS, Sexual orientation is included in the County's Personnel Ordinance and is the preferred term used when referring to an individual's physical and/or emotional attraction to the same and/or opposite gender. "Gay," "lesbian," "bisexual" and "straight" are all examples of sexual orientations; and

WHEREAS, Gender identity is distinct from the term "sexual orientation," and refers to a person's innate, deeply felt psychological identification as a man, woman or some other gender, which may or may not correspond to the sex assigned to them at birth (e.g., the sex listed on their birth certificate); and

WHEREAS, Gender expression refers to all of the external characteristics and behaviors that are socially defined as either masculine or feminine, such as dress, grooming, mannerisms, speech patterns and social interactions. Social or cultural norms can vary widely and some characteristics that may be accepted as masculine, feminine, or neutral in one culture may not be assessed similarly in another; and

WHEREAS, adding gender identity and gender expression to the Personnel Ordinance has been suggested by the resolution author to provide additional clarity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board of Supervisors assembled this day of March, 2015 does hereby amend Chapter XVIII, Section 18.102 B (d) of the County's Personnel Ordinance as follows:

CHAPTER XVIII

PERSONNEL ORDINANCE <u>SECTION 1</u>

OBJECTIVES AND SCOPE

18.102 <u>Purposes.</u>

- B. Establish a uniform County Personnel Policy and procedures to recruit, select, develop and maintain an effective and responsive workforce for the County. The Ordinance shall be based on the following objectives:
 - (d) To assure fair treatment of all applicants and employees in all aspects of personnel administration without regard to political affiliation or beliefs, race, color, national origin or ancestry, sex, age, religion, disability, sexual identity and orientation, gender identity, gender expression, genetic information, or any other cause for discrimination as defined by law, except as allowable as a bonafide occupational requirement, and with proper regard for their rights as citizens.
