EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Through Wisconsin Act 27 (1997-1999 Biennial Budget Bill), Chapter 92.10 of the Wisconsin Statutes was amended, creating a county land and water resource management-planning program. Wisconsin Administrative Code ATCP 50, details the requirement of the Land and Water Resource Management Plan. The original plan, approved in 1998, was one of the five original Land and Water Resource Management Plans in the State of Wisconsin. The original plan has been updated every five (5) years since the original plans publication date. The most current plan, dated 2019, incorporates new natural resource information.

This edition incorporates five natural resource management goals: Protect the quality and quantity of Groundwater; Protection of Farmlands; Protect quality of Surface waters; Improve and protect soil quality; and Protect and enhance habitat quality. It is a 10-year action and implementation plan that emphasizes cooperation with conservation partners in Rock County. The plan must be reviewed after five years by the State Land and Water Conservation Board.

The LWRM Plan is intended to complement and coordinate with existing plans rather than replace them. By focusing on the Rock County Land Conservation Committee (LCC) and Land Conservation Department's (LCD) strengths of conservation planning, information and education, technical assistance, and program administration, diverse interests act together in effective protection and enhancement of Rock County's natural resources.

In summary, the LWRM Plan outlines a comprehensive strategy for the implementation of protection of the natural resources. This will only be accomplished through continued partnerships with governmental agencies, landowners, non-governmental organizations, and the citizens of Rock County.
