

#### 10.A. <u>UW Rock County Update – Dean Carmen Wilson</u>

Dean Wilson presented details of the proposed 2016-2017 Budget cuts for the UW system and how UW Rock County campus will be impacted. She shared that enrollment in the 2014-2015 academic year was about 1,100. They believe that students choose UW Rock County because it is affordable, accessible, has high academic excellence standards, holds a supportive environment and offers a guaranteed transfer option.

Tuition at UW Rock County is \$5,108 per year. Other campuses such as the UW Madison campus costs \$10,403 per year, which is more than double. UW Milwaukee tuition costs are \$9,300 per year. UW Rock County offers services to students in the areas of advising, learning support, student clubs and organizations, and Rattlers athletics (Men's and Women's Basketball, volleyball, co-ed soccer and tennis).

This budget proposes a continued tuition freeze. It also cuts \$150 million dollars each year and is on-going. The UW Rock County's annual budget is currently about \$6.5 million. The proposed UW colleges cuts spanning the 13 campuses is also estimated at about \$6.5 million. Because of the prior budgets the UW Rock County campus is operating at a 1998 budget level. So Dean Wilson said that they are "offering a 21st century education/institution on a 20th century budget."

The Budget reduction plans currently are seeking to centralize the following functions: Tuitions, IT services, Student recruitment, marketing, HR, and library director. They also have discussed regionalizing the following roles: Dean, Assistant Deans in the areas of student affairs, administration and finance, and academics, Director of Communications, Director of Facilities, and the Director of Continuing Education.

In the first round of cuts, Dean Wilson explained that the following was for sure happening:

- Consolidation of Admissions
- Consolidation of Financial Aid
- Accessibility Services
- Veteran Services
- Recruiting
- Student Conduct/Compliance
- IT Functions
- Library Directors
- Research alternatives for custodial services (also known as outsourcing)

Dean Wilson explained that they will need to find the best way to serve students with these functions being centralizing and regionalized. She is uncertain at this time what the potential impact might be to students seeking quality educational offerings at UW Rock County but holds the campus commitment to all students that they will continue to be a top notch campus. Round 2 of the cuts are due to be announced in early June.

When asked if these cuts would impact the residence hall plans, she emphasized that it would not. If anything, it would create a stronger sense of urgency to be more attractive and allow for more recruitment regionally.
