# Accepting Additional Maternal & Child Health Grant Funds and Amending the 2019 Rock County Public Health Department Budget

### **Executive Summary**

The Title V Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Services Block Grant creates Federal-State-Local partnerships to develop state and local systems to meet the critical challenges facing women, children and families. The Rock County Public Health Department utilizes these funds to support work related to breast feeding and safe sleep. Our objectives surrounding breastfeeding include supporting workplaces and childcare sites to become breastfeeding friendly along with supporting community groups to become breastfeeding friendly by promoting consistent messaging. Our objective surrounding safe sleep involves coordinating and/or providing trainings to implement safe sleep practices with childcare providers and community groups using common messaging. We also promote safe sleep policies and procedures developed for hospitals and health systems. We were awarded an additional \$7,701 to support our work.
