# <u>Amending the Sheriff's 2012 Budget to Use Equitably Shared Funds – Helmet Communicators</u>

#### **Executive Summary**

#### Amending the Sheriff's 2012 Budget to Use Equitably Shared Funds – Helmet Communicators

The Department of Justice Asset Forfeiture Program is a nationwide law enforcement initiative that removes the tools of crime from criminal organizations and deprives wrongdoers of the proceeds of their crimes. Federal law authorizes the Attorney General to share federally forfeited property with participating state and local law enforcement agencies.

Equitably shared funds are required to be used by law enforcement agencies for law enforcement purposes only. The intent of the transfer is to enhance law enforcement. It must increase, not supplant the recipient's appropriated operating budget.

For their participation in the program, the Sheriff's Office received funds in the amount of \$1,724. The Sheriff's Office plans to use the funds to purchase two wireless helmet communicator kits.

The hands free communicators will be installed in helmets of the new motorcycle officers. The communications use hands free, blue tooth technology. The blue tooth technology enables the deputies to keep both hands on the handle bars while still being able to communicate with dispatch or other officers. The communications are not moveable from one helmet to another, and each deputy needs their own helmet.
