EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Communications Center's 9-1-1 telephone system (Intrado VIPER A9C) was installed in October of 2013 and the backroom equipment (servers and information systems) is due for replacement. Typically the equipment lifespan is 5-7 years. Front room equipment was replaced in 2019. The quote includes the replacement of the standalone Viper hardware/software upgrade and moving to a new management information system for telephone activity reporting.

Rock County IT has been the maintenance provider for the 911 telephone system for the past six years so the quote also includes additional training to maintain the servers.
