10.A. <u>Rock County Human Services reports on the Impact of Affordable Care Act on Economic</u> <u>Support Division.</u>

Human Services Director, Charmian Klyve, Deputy Director Phil Boutwell and Carla Haigh presented the report.

Carla began with a historical background on *Income Maintenance* at the County level. The State previously contracted with individual counties for Income Maintenance Services, but Proceedings of the Rock County Board of Supervisors June 13, 2013

the last biennial budget required 10 consortia to be created. Rock County is the Fiscal and Administrative Lead Agency in the Southern Consortium with Jefferson, Green, Iowa, Lafayette, Grant and Crawford. Operations began January 1, 2012 and the call center currently services over 43,000 cases between the 7 counties, with Rock County making up nearly 50% of the caseload.

The broader impacts of the Affordable Care Act include the fact that it requires everyone to have health insurance through a standard application process called MAGI. Medicaid is the coverage for the uninsured poor and those without private insurance or employer provided coverage are directed to the "marketplace." Changes begin taking place October 1, 2013.

Major changes include eligibility requirements for BadgerCare, which means a significant workload increase for Economic Support. \$38.1 million of new GPR and matching federal funds has been appropriated over the biennium and changes the DHS funding formula to pay the consortia for the additional work. In order to plan for the workload increase, much will be necessary, beginning with space and location planning. There will be a necessity to purchase technology and FF&E, the hiring of new staff, training of existing and new staff, and several budget approvals and management decisions.

Carla reviewed the timeline for these changes in order to meet the October 1, 2013 ACA responsibility. A Resolution is forthcoming to the Board of Supervisors that will be accepting additional IM allocations and amending the 2013 Budget to meet the requirements discussed in tonight's report.
