DIRECTOR'S REPORT ON PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

1. Program Activities:

- The Department is continuing to work closely with the State and HSD on the transition of eight individuals currently being served through the BIW. Per the State, a tentative May 1st effective date is being offered as the transition date.
- The Department is working closely with Catholic Charities, our day services programs, and the school systems for transitioning and then opening up to five individuals that will be graduating in June of this year and proactive moves based upon needs. Most of these openings will be filing current vacancies within existing programs.

2. Budget Updates:

 Mr. Hanewall just finished writing the COP High Cost Narrative Report for 2013. In summary, the Department/County received 21 awards in 2013. These awards paid for consultations, additional short term staff issues, and equipment such as beds, walkers, etc. In total the State awards amount to \$51,764. This is money that the County did not have to use to pay for these services.

3. Residential Placements

- On Friday, March 21st, we moved a gentleman into a new AFH due to his previous provider giving notice.
- We are currently working on a couple of other residential vacancies and we are coordinating referrals and service plans with case managers.

4. Consumer Updates

• Thursday, March 20th, we had a gentleman pass away at Beloit Health & Rehab. He had lived in the Beaver Dam area for the past three years and suffered a stroke. He was transferred to Beloit Health & Rehab but continued to decline. He was 65 years old.
