WHEREAS, one in 25 adults lives in the United States with mental illness such as major depression, bipolar disorder or schizophrenia; and

WHEREAS, approximately one-half of chronic mental illness begins by the age of 14 and three-quarters
 begin by age 24; and

WHEREAS, long delays often occur between the time symptoms first appear and when individuals get help; and

WHEREAS, early identification and treatment can make a profound difference in successful management of mental illness and recovery; and

WHEREAS, it is important to maintain mental health and learn the symptoms of mental illness in order to get help when it is needed; and

WHEREAS, every citizen in Rock County can make a difference in helping end the silence and stigma that for too long has surrounded mental illness and discouraged people from getting help; and

WHEREAS, Rock County is committed to supporting public education and activities for its residents that can encourage mental health and help improve the lives of individuals and families affected by mental illness; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Rock County Board of Supervisors, in session this 28th day of April, 2016, that they proclaim May 2016 as Mental Health Awareness Month in Rock County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors encourages increased public understanding of the importance of mental health and promotes identification and treatment of mental illnesses.
