Executive Summary

Requesting Supplemental ARPA Funding for Emergency Management Warming Shelter Program and Amending the 2022 Budget

Resolution #22-1A-406 authorized use of ARPA funds to provide warming shelter lodging under the auspices of the Sheriff's Office Emergency Management Bureau cold weather event declaration. \$25,000 was allocated and was based upon last year's winter season.

For this winter season, Emergency Management declared the following dates as severe weather events:

- 1. 1/1/22 to 1/3/22 (2 nights)
- 1/5/22 to 1/11/22 (6 nights)
 1/19/22 to 1/29/22 (12 nights)
- 4. 2/1/22 to 2/5/22 (4 nights)
