Those jurisdictions that use the state health plan through the Employee Trust Fund (ETF) provide the benefit to domestic partners of either same or opposite sex.

I've provided a copy of the City of Beloit Resolution (for same sex couples only), the City of Janesville Resolution (for both same sex and opposite sex couples) and the Dane County form for both same sex and opposite sex partners.

WHEREAS, the City of Beloit is an organization committed to non-discrimination, as expressed in applicable City ordinances and the City's non-discrimination policies regarding provision of services and employment; and

WHEREAS, those non-discrimination ordinances and policies include a commitment not to discriminate on the basis of sexual orientation or family status; and

WHEREAS, many current employers including the State of Wisconsin, several other Wisconsin municipalities, institutions of higher education, and private sector employers have extended employee benefits to same gender domestic partners and their dependents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Beloit compensates employees through more than just wages and salary by providing a range of benefits to the employees, including health care, prescription drug coverage, dental insurance, and other employee benefits offered consistent with the traditional plan structure including opposite gender spouses and dependents of the City's employees; and

WHEREAS, extension of benefits including health care, prescription drug coverage, dental insurance, and other employee benefits not currently required by law to be extended to same gender domestic partners and their dependents would increase the attractiveness of the City's employment benefit package, thus facilitating successful employee recruitment and retention; and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats. Sec. 40.02(21d) provides a definition of "domestic partners" for Wisconsin Retirement System and certain State health insurance benefit purposes and Wis. Stats. Sec. 770.01(1) also defines that term for the purposes of the Wisconsin Domestic Partnership Registry; and

WHEREAS, the Beloit City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the City to extend employment benefits to domestic partners as that term is defined in Wis. Stats. 770.01(1).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Beloit shall allow access to and offer health care, prescription drug coverage, dental insurance, and other employee benefits to domestic partners of City employees in the same fashion such benefits are extended to spouses of married City employees. Such benefits shall be provided to the extent allowed by the IRS and otherwise allowed by law, specifically including any amendments or new enactments of Wisconsin laws relating to domestic partners, civil unions or same sex marriages; and should such amendments or enactments occur, such benefits shall be extended as allowed therein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City will extend health care, prescription drug coverage, dental insurance, and other employee benefits to all qualifying domestic partners of City employees according to the following guidelines:

1. The definition of domestic partnership of same gender couples used by the City of Beloit will be that used by Wis. Stats. Sec. 40.02(21d) and 770.01(1).

- 2. The City of Beloit shall require verification of current valid domestic partner registration pursuant to Wis. Stats. Chapter 770, the Domestic Partnership Act, or the documentation required by any subsequent change in state law.
- 3. The provision of these benefits will be extended to the dependents of those same gender domestic partners as they would be to the dependents of legally married employees under the then current provision for dependent coverage in the relevant benefit program.
- 4. The benefits provided to domestic partners and their dependents shall be as nearly equal as possible to those offered to legally married partners, including non-insurance benefits such as funeral leave for the death of a domestic partner and use of sick leave to care for a domestic partner.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective on January 1, 2014.

Executive Summary

Earlier this year, Council Members Liebert and Rashkin requested that the City consider granting health plan benefits to the domestic partners of eligible City employees, and funeral leave to employees with domestic partners. At the February 13, 2012 meeting, the City Council approved funeral leave for eligible employees with domestic partners, and deferred domestic partner health plan coverage for the new Council Subsequently, Council Members Liebert and Steeber requested that this matter be brought forward at the Council's November 12, 2012 meeting.

As a result of the domestic partner inquiry, the Human Resources Division:

1. Conducted a survey of Wisconsin Public Employers Labor Relations Association (WPELRA) to see if member cities, counties, or technical colleges provide benefits to domestic partners, and if so, what are the benefits, and eligibility criteria.

2. Reviewed the matter with our health plan third party administrator to obtain their

thoughts and advice.

It is difficult to estimate the number of City and Library employees who have a domestic partner. Currently, there are 78 unmarried employees with single medical plan coverage. However, we don't track the number of single parents with family medical plan coverage, and who live with a domestic partner. There are unknowns in adding this benefit, making the City's cost impact difficult to predict. Based on the experience of other public employers with this coverage, the estimated cost impact to the City's Insurance Fund would most likely be less than 1% of medical claims per year. The annual cost impact to the General Fund is estimated at \$9,915.00 for an employee changing from single to family medical coverage, plus \$633.00 for dental coverage per employee¹. So, for example, if three General Fund employees enrolled their domestic partner, then the City's added cost would be \$31,644.00.

Recommendation

There is no staff recommendation on extending health plan benefits to the domestic partners of employees.

¹ Totaling \$10,548 per employee, and based upon 2012 premium rates.

City Manager Recommendation

The City Manager views this more as a policy decision than a fiscal decision. An employee with a domestic partner would be treated in the same manner as an employee who had a spouse or a family. Thus, the fiscal impact would be no different than if an employee had family coverage.

Suggested Motion

If Council decides to approve this benefit eligibility, then the proposed motion would be "I move to approve File Resolution Number 2012-910."

Key Points to Consider

- 1. The experience of other public sector employers indicates that the additional cost for domestic partner benefits is less than 1% of their health plan costs.
- 2. At the same time, there is an unknown and potential risk in extending health care benefits to the domestic partners of employees based on possible adverse utilization. We believe the criteria to determine eligibility will control any adverse selection.
- 3. The cost to the General Fund depends upon the number of employees enrolling their domestic partner and the medical plan they select.
- 4. Although this is currently changing (see Survey Results #5), most Wisconsin counties and municipalities do not offer domestic partner benefits unless they are part of the State Health Plan
- 5. Adding domestic partner benefits would result in added administrative work since a special enrollment process would need to be offered.
- 6. If the decision is to provide domestic partner benefits, then should they be provided to same gender domestic partners, opposite gender, or both? The draft Resolution provides for both same gender and opposite gender domestic partners.
- 7. Implementing benefit changes varies by employee group:
 - A. Benefit changes may be implemented for Administrative and Library (nonrepresented) employees.
 - B. We are advised that under the new collective bargaining law, benefit changes may be implemented for General Municipal Union employees (DPW), as long as the effective date is January 1, 2013, after the expiration of the current labor agreement.
 - C. The City would have a duty to bargain this health plan eligibility change with Teamsters Union employees.
 - D. Police and Fire Unions' ability to collectively bargain health plan matters other than premium contributions is in flux, with Circuit Court judge decisions on both sides of the issue. Cases are on appeal, and may ultimately be decided by the Wisconsin Supreme Court. Until such time as a final decision is made, we are advised to follow the WERC's decision that public safety unions' rights are limited to bargaining the premium contributions.

Current Benefits for the Domestic Partners of City Employees

Under the Wisconsin Family and Medical Leave, employees may take State FMLA for the serious health condition of their domestic partner and for the domestic partner's parent.

Under the Wisconsin Retirement System (WRS), employees may purchase life insurance coverage for his or her domestic partner, the same as an employee would make this purchase for a spouse.

Survey Results

On 8 September 2011, a survey was distributed by email to approximately 107 WPELRA members with a requested return date of September 16th. In response, 38 completed surveys were returned.

- 1. Four responded that they follow the Wisconsin Statute definition (40.02.(21d)) of domestic partner, which is copied and pasted below: "Domestic partnership" means a relationship between 2 individuals that satisfies all of the following:
 - (a) Each individual is at least 18 years old and otherwise competent to enter into a contract.
 - (b) Neither individual is married to, or in a domestic partnership with, another individual.
 - (c) The 2 individuals are not related by blood in any way that would prohibit marriage under s.
 - (d) The 2 individuals consider themselves to be members of each other's immediate family.
 - (e) The 2 individuals agree to be responsible for each other's basic living expenses.
 - (f) The 2 individuals share a common residence. Two individuals may share a common residence even if any of the following applies:
 - 1. Only one of the individuals has legal ownership of the residence.
 - 2. One or both of the individuals have one or more additional residences not shared with the other individual.
 - 3. One of the individuals leaves the common residence with the intent to return.
- 2. The City of Appleton and Rock County allow employees to have paid time off for bereavement or funeral leave for the domestic partner.
- 3. The City of Appleton and Price County allow employees to use sick leave for the illness of a domestic partner.
- 4. The City of Fitchburg and Western Wisconsin Cares, with the State Health Plan², offer health insurance to employees' domestic partners.
- 5. The City of Appleton has its own Health Plan offers health coverage to employees' same gender domestic partners. (Since the Council's February 13, 2012 meeting, the cities of Racine, Eau Claire, and Manitowoc approved health coverage for same gender domestic partners.)
- 6. Most employers do not require County registration of a same gender relationship.
- 7. The WRS requires employees and their domestic partners to complete an affidavit so that the employee's domestic partner may receive WRS related benefits, e.g., life insurance, health insurance.

A review of the City of Madison's website indicates that it participates in the State Health Plan and WRS, and, therefore offers health and life insurance to the domestic partners of their employees.

A review of the County and City of Milwaukee's website indicates that it offers health and dental benefits to the domestic partners of their employees in 18 of their 25 Unions. The children of domestic partners are not covered by the City's health and dental plans.

² The State Health Plan provides domestic partners coverage.

Third Party Claims Administrator

For health plan purposes, our claims administrator can implement any decision the City should make in this matter, and brought up the following points that would need to be addressed if domestic partner benefits are offered:

1. Our stop loss insurer needs to be notified of, and approve, an eligibility change.

2. Domestic partner must be clearly defined.

3. An open enrollment must be scheduled to allow employees to enroll their domestic partner.

4. An effective date must be identified for domestic partner coverage.

5. Dean's insured business offers health plan benefits to domestic partners. Dean requires that the employee and his or her domestic partner complete an affidavit, and provide proof of their common residence.

Cost Impact To The General Fund

In the General Fund, premium rates are set prospectively, and will not vary during the fiscal year, regardless of health claims experience. Departments are charged amounts based upon single or family coverage and employee plan selection. Based upon claims experience in one year, the General Fund rates would be adjusted accordingly for the following year.

The annual cost impact to the General Fund is estimated at \$9,915.00 for an employee changing from single to family medical coverage, plus \$633.00 for dental coverage per employee¹. So, for example, if five General Fund employees enrolled their domestic partner, then the General Fund's added cost would be \$52,740.00.

Cost Impact ToThe Insurance Fund

Since the City self-funds its health plan, it takes on an unknown risk whenever it enrolls an employee and/or dependent. The experience of other public employers indicates that adding domestic partners costs less than 1% per year. In the City's case, an additional cost of ½% to 1% would equal approximately \$35,000 to \$70,000 per year, based upon estimated 2012 medical claims. Other studies urge caution that adverse selection could result in cost increases of 3% even if only a small number of employees choose domestic partner benefits. For the City, if this were to happen, a 3% increase to the Insurance Fund equates to \$210,000 per year. The difficulty of adverse selection is that the City won't know the cost impact until it occurs.

A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND HEALTH CARE BENEFTS TO ALL OTHERWISE QUALIFYING CITY AND LIBRARY DOMESTIC PARTNER EMPLOYEES AND THEIR FAMILIES

WHEREAS the City and Library have a non-discrimination policy which states all persons are given equal consideration without regard to race, creed (religion), color, sex, national origin, handicap as defined in the Americans with Disability Act, ancestry, arrest or conviction record, marital status, membership in Military Reserve, sexual orientation, or age..."; and

WHEREAS the City and Library are committed to being a leader within the community with regard to diversity..."; and

WHEREAS, the City and Library are committed to equal treatment of all employee families and couples; an inequity currently exists concerning certain employee benefits for same gender and opposite gender employees that is contrary to a fundamental sense of human fairness; and

WHEREAS, employers compensate employees through more than just wages and salary by providing benefits such as health plan coverage, with the traditional benefits structure including an employee's opposite-sex spouse and children;

WHEREAS, extension of all benefits not currently required by law to be extended to same gender and opposite gender employees and their families would satisfy this fundamental fairness inequity and be in the best interest of and benefit to the City and the Library, its employees, taxpayers, and community; and

WHEREAS, such extension of benefits including, but not limited to, health care, prescription drug, dental, and vision care benefit packages to same gender and opposite gender domestic partners who otherwise would qualify (e.g. vesting requirements, hours per week, etc.) would increase the attractiveness of the City and the Library's employment benefit package, thus, significantly facilitating successful employee recruitment and retention; and

WHEREAS, current societal standards as annunciated by the State of Wisconsin, Milwaukee County, the Cities of Madison, Milwaukee, Fitchburg, Appleton, other Wisconsin communities, many institutions of higher education, and private sector employers is to extend health care to all qualifying same gender and opposite gender domestic partners and their families; and

WHEREAS, Wis. Stats. Sec. 40.02(21d) provides some limited guidance as to the definition of "domestic partners" for Wisconsin Retirement System and certain State health insurance benefit purposes; and

WHEREAS, the General Fund cost is based upon health plan rates that are set prospectively, and will not vary during the fiscal year, regardless of health claims experience. The annual cost impact to the General Fund is estimated at \$9,915.00 for an employee changing from single to family medical coverage, plus \$633.00 for dental coverage per employee (based on 2012 premium rates).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Janesville that this Council stands for the proposition that same gender and opposite gender domestic partners be allowed access to and provided all of the same health care, prescription drug, dental, vision care, which are extended to opposite gender spouse relationships to which the latter are currently and, from time to time, may be entitled, and as are allowed by the IRS, commencing January 1, 2013, to the extent allowed by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Council requests and directs that the City Administration:

(a) Study and consult with the City's health care advisors and others to determine appropriate definitions, standards, and related administrative procedures and processes for such extension; and

(b) Extend health care, prescription drug, dental, and vision care to all qualifying opposite gender and same gender domestic partners of Administrative, General Municipal, and Library employees, and their children commencing January 1, 2013, to the extent allowed by law; and

(c) Negotiate as appropriate, the extension of health care, prescription drug, dental, and vision care to all qualifying opposite gender and same gender domestic partners of Union employees and their children during collective bargaining negotiations for 2013, to the extent allowed by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administration include the costs arising from such extension in the proposed budget for fiscal/calendar year 2013.

Proposed Domestic Partner Health Plan Eligibility

Definition of Domestic Partner

Domestic Partners are two individuals who both meet all of the following criteria (combination of State Statute and Dean's definition):

1. Are 18 years of age or older;

2. Are competent to enter into a contract;

- 3. Are not married or part of an existing domestic partnership with any third person;
- 4. Are not related to one another by marriage, or blood closer than permitted under the marriage laws of the State of Wisconsin;
- 5. Have entered into the Domestic Partnership voluntarily, willingly, and without
- 6. Have not entered into the domestic partner relationship for the purpose of obtaining health plan coverage;
- 7. Have been engaged in a committed relationship with each other for more than 12 -18 months (to be determined) immediately prior to date of application of coverage;
- 8. Intend to continue the Domestic Partnership indefinitely, with the understanding that the relationship is terminable at the will of either partner;
- 9. Consider themselves to be members of each other's immediate family;
- 10. Are in a mutually exclusive relationship and share responsibility for each other's common welfare, financial obligations, and basic living expenses (proof of such will be required, e.g., ownership of residence, copy of lease, joint checking or savings account):
- 11 Share a common residence;

Enrollment Requirements

To enroll a Domestic Partner, the Subscriber and Domestic Partner must submit either proof of a Declaration of Domestic Partnership with the Rock County Clerk of the State of Wisconsin, or an Affidavit of Domestic Partnership with the Employer; and an enrollment form. The subscriber's Employer will complete an Enrollment of a Domestic Partner Checklist. The Employer, or its third party administrator reserve the right to verify the information provided at any time.

Domestic Partners shall become effective on the same basis as other Qualified Dependents, as described in the Plan Document. The establishment of a Domestic Partner relationship does not have the same legal meaning as marriage. Therefore, the special enrollment provisions applicable as a result of marriage do not apply to Domestic Partners or their children.

Termination of Domestic Partnership Coverage

Coverage of a Domestic Partner and his/her dependent children may be terminated at any time upon the completion of a Statement of Termination of Domestic Partnership Coverage signed by the Subscriber Neither terminated Domestic Partners nor their dependent children have a right to continuation coverage under Federal or State law.

I was forwarded your email from Brett Berg. My name is Mary Ann Kahl and I am the Assistant Director of Administrative and Human Services for the School District of Janesville. In late spring, the Board of Education voted to expand our health benefits to domestic partners.

We require our eligible employees (eligible for health benefits with the District) to file a notarized Affidavit of Domestic Partnership. They must certify that they:

- are at least 18 years old and legally competent,
- are not married to another person,
- are not in a Chapter 40 domestic partnership with another person,
- are not related by blood in a way that would prohibit marriage in Wisconsin,
- consider themselves to be members of each other's immediate family,
- agree to be responsible for each other's basic living expenses, and
- share a common residence.

Domestic partners, for the purpose of our benefits, refers to either same sex or opposite sex partners.
